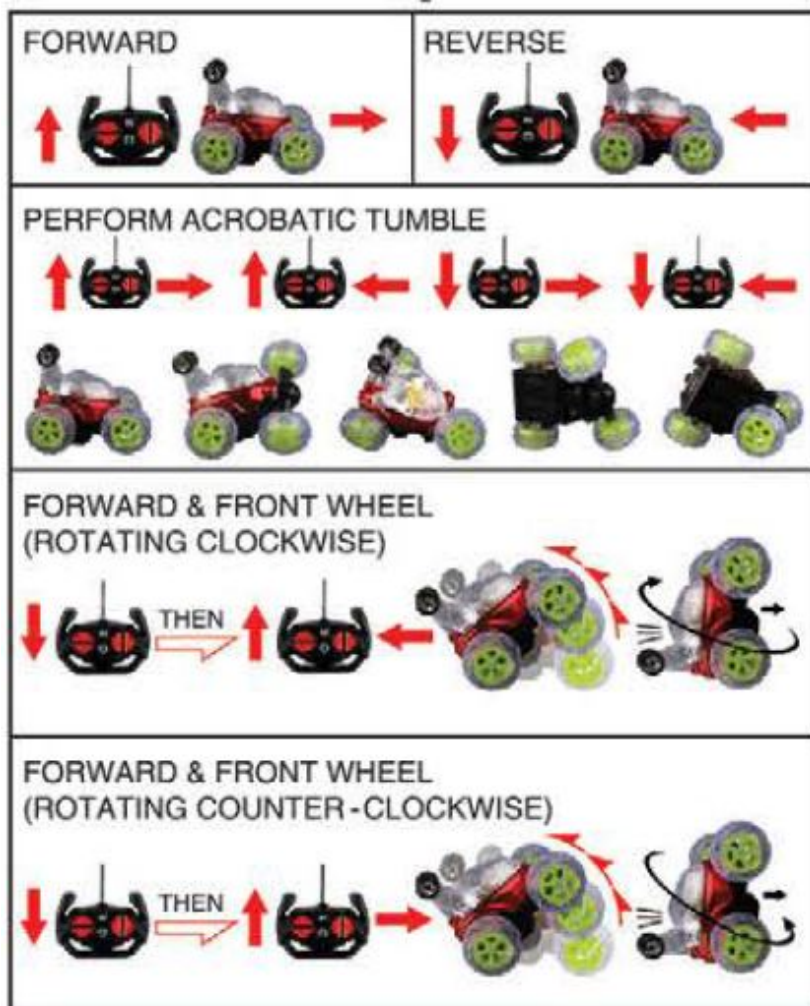

ILLUSTRATED INSTRUCTIONS

1. Turn power switch ON with LIGHTS ONLY or ON with LIGHTS and SOUND.
2. Use the forward/reverse and left/right buttons on remote to control the vehicle.



WARNING

- This toy is intended for use by children ages 5 and up.
- Please review this manual with your child. Adult supervision suggested.
- Do not operate on streets or roads.
- Keep away from water.
- Avoid use on carpet, sand and dust.
- Avoid bumping the vehicle into people, animals or objects.

CHANGING THE BATTERY

1. Make sure the power switch is OFF.
2. Unscrew and remove the battery door.
3. Replace batteries as shown and replace the door.
4. When car slows or lights become dim, replace the batteries again.

OPERATION

1. Turn power switch ON.
2. Use forward/reverse and left/right joysticks for vehicle control.
3. Use sound button on remote to change the music or mute the sounds.

4. When finished turn the car OFF.
