Instructions

1. Charging the speaker

- 1. Connect the provided charging cable to a power source and to the Micro USB input port(2) on the speaker.
- 2. The charging LED indicator(3) will glow RED when charging and will tum off when fully charged.


2. Connecting the speaker with Bluetooth

- 1. Press and hold the power button(4) to tum ON the speaker, Bluetooth LED indicator(1) will flash BLUE.
- 2. Using a Bluetooth-enabled device, search for cylinder Cement Speaker" from the list of available options. Toe LED(3) will turn solid BLUE when paired successfully.
- 3. Press and hold the power button(1) to tum OFF the speaker

3. Using the Speaker

- 1. When playing audio, press the power button to pause the music. Press again to resume playing the audio.
- 2. Use your mobile device to flange songs end adjust the volume.
