- Automatic Temp & Texture System
- · Adjustable temperature and texture control
- Designed for heating and texturizing milk
- · Comes with temperature and texture control boards
- · Adjustment screw for fine-tuning milk volume and texture

Product Usage Instructions

Temperature Adjustment

- 1. Remove the lid of the machine to access the temperature and texture control boards.
- 2. Locate the adjustment screw on the temperature control board.
- 3. Using a very small flat screwdriver (Jeweller's screwdriver), turn the adjustment screw so that it points towards the arrowhead (starting position).
- 4. Fill a jug with cold water, then heat it using the automatic temp & texture system to check the temperature adjustment.

Texture Adjustment

- 1. To adjust the volume of stretched milk, turn the adjustment screw clockwise to increase volume or anticlockwise to reduce volume.
- 2. Fine tuning is required to achieve the desired texture and density of stretched milk. This may vary based on the brand of milk being used.

Frequently Asked Questions

· Q: How do I know when the milk has reached the desired temperature?


 A: You can use a thermometer to check the milk temperature. Adjust the temperature control accordingly to achieve the desired result.

Q: Can I use this machine for heating purposes other than milk?

 A: This machine is specifically designed for heating and texturizing milk. It is not recommended for other purposes.


Temperature adjustment

- 1. Remove the lid of the machine and locate the temperature and texture control boards pictured below.
- 2. Using a very small flat screwdriver (Jeweller's screwdriver) turn the adjustment screw so that it points toward the arrowhead (starting position).
- 3. Fill a jug with cold water then heat it with the automatic temp & texture system, whilst heating check the temperature with a digital thermometer. Note the maximum temperature which will occur shortly after the system stops.
- 4. If the temperature is too cool turn the adjustment screw anti-clockwise slightly, if it is too hot then turn the adjustment screw clockwise slightly.
- 5. Repeat step 2 until you reach the desired temperature (a temperature of 65°C is good).



Texture adjustment

1. To increase the volume of stretched milk turn the adjustment screw clockwise, to reduce milk volume turn it anti-clockwise. Fine-tuning will be required to get the right texture and density of stretched milk, depending on the brand of milk you are using.
