## Product Usage Instructions

### Main Device (Droid)

1. Insert 6 AA 1.5V batteries into the battery compartment as per the battery diagram.
2. Ensure the batteries are properly aligned according to the polarity markings.
3. Turn on the main device using the designated power button.
4. Follow the user manual for specific instructions on operating the Droid.

### Remote Control

1. Insert 2 AAA 1.5V batteries into the battery compartment following the battery diagram.
2. Make sure the batteries are inserted correctly based on the polarity indicators.
3. Use the remote control to interact with the main device and navigate its functions.


## FAQ

- **Q:** Can I use rechargeable batteries with the device?
- **A:** It is recommended to use non-rechargeable batteries as specified in the user manual for optimal

performance.

- **Q:** What should I do if the device does not power on?
- **A:** Check the battery compartment for correct battery insertion and polarity. Replace with new batteries if needed.
- **Q:** Is it safe to use the device in close proximity to people?
- **A:** The device meets general RF exposure requirements and can be used in portable conditions without restrictions, ensuring safety during operation.



## INSTRUCTIONS


### Pairing Steps

1. Hold down the pairing button on the underside of the Droid body (as shown in the image). Release the button after the LED starts blinking.
2. Make sure the Remote Control is in the “OFF” position. While holding down the “Forward” and “Accessory” buttons together at the same time (as shown in the image), slide switch to the “ON” position. The LED on the Remote Control should start blinking.
3. When paired successfully, both the LED on the Droid and the Remote Control will turn off.

## Sleep Mode




**Note:** Droid will go to sleep if not active on Batu or at home after 5 minutes. To wake up the droid, slide the power switch off and then back to on.


## DROID BATTERY DIAGRAM


