Product Information:

The DJI RC Motion 2 is a set of goggles designed for use with a DJI drone. It has a built-in transmitter that allows for real-time video transmission from the drone to the goggles. The goggles have a high-resolution display and offer a first-person view of the drone's flight.

Product Usage:

- 1. **Goggles:** Do not use or store the goggles in environments with adverse weather conditions or high levels of humidity or dust. Do not use the goggles while in a moving vehicle or while doing physical exercise such as running. Fold the antennas to avoid damage when the goggles are not in use.
- 2. Goggles Battery: DO NOT allow liquid to come into contact with the batteries. DO NOT leave batteries covered in moisture or out in the rain. DO NOT drop the batteries into water. Otherwise, an explosion or fire may occur. DO NOT use non-DJI batteries. DO NOT use swollen, leaking, or damaged batteries. In such situations, contact DJI or a DJI authorized dealer.
