DJO Drop Foot Boot/External Rotation Boot

INTENDED USER PROFILE:

INTENDED USE/INDICATIONS:

To provide support and protection to the foot post-operatively. Soft-good/semi-rigid designed to restrict motion through elastic or semi-rigid construction.

- Do not use over open wounds.
- If pain, swelling, changes in sensation or other unusual reactions occur while using this product, you should contact your doctor immediately.
- Do not use this device if it was damaged and/or package has been opened.

APPLICATION INFORMATION:

1. Place foot in liner with the heel seated as far back in the pocket as possible. Secure closures. (Fig. 1)
2. The angle may be adjusted by loosening the wingnut at the bottom of the boot. Position at desired angle. Retighten wingnut. (Fig. 2)

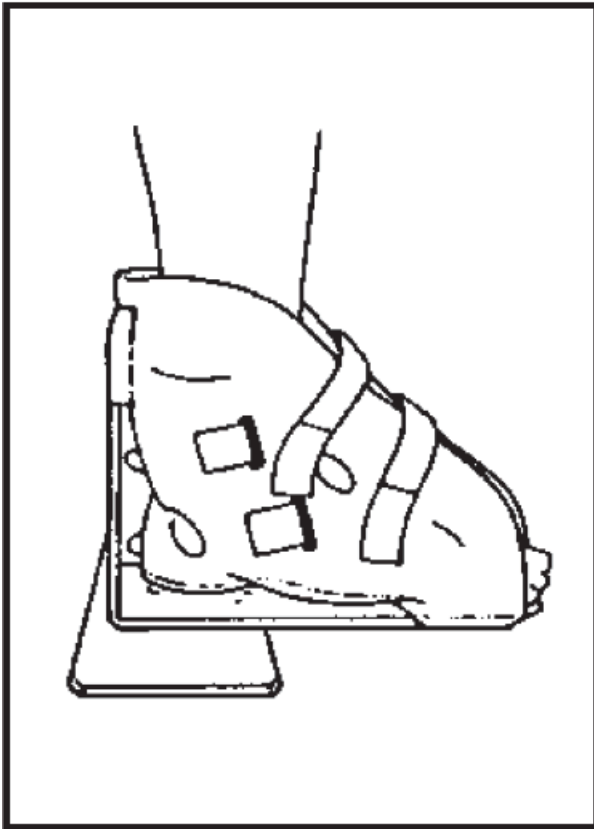

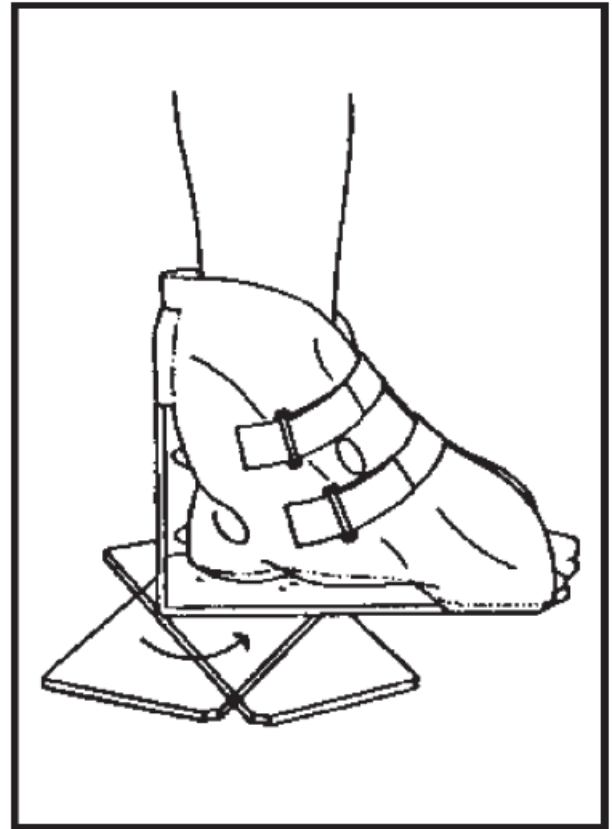

DISPOSABLE LINER ONLY AND FRAME ONLY:

3. Slip liner over frame and secure across the bottom of the foot. Apply as in steps A-B above.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

The frame may be wiped down to clean. The liner may be hand washed in cold water with mild detergent and air dried.
