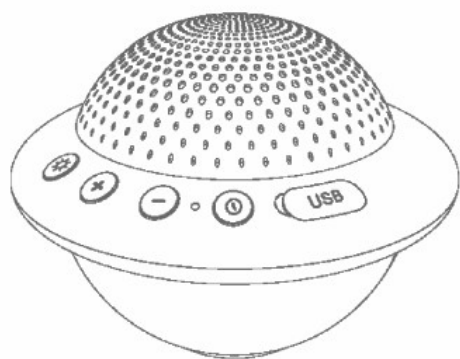

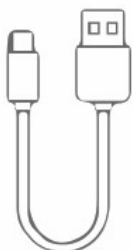

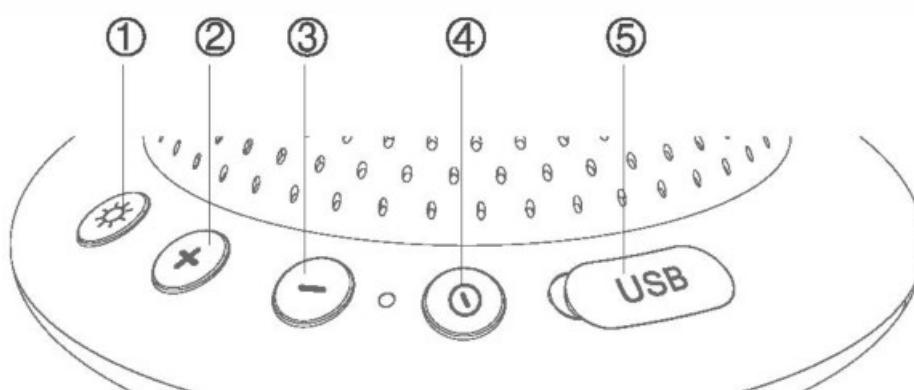

## BUTTONS

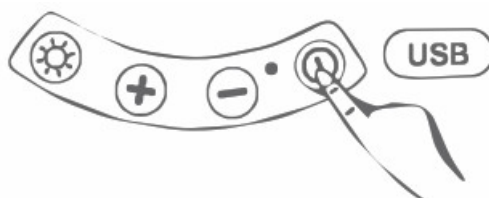




1. Light Button

## USING YOUR SPEAKER



Turn on/off



Light Indicator	Status
 Blue light flashing	Power on
 Light off	Power off

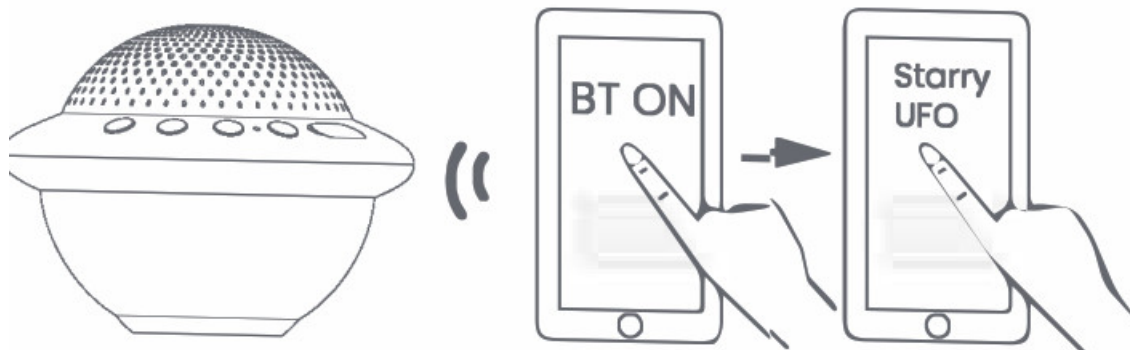
Press and hold the power button for 3s to power on your speaker. You may hear a voice prompt "Power on, Bluetooth mode" and the Speakers automatically enter pairing mode.





The speaker will not automatically turn off if no device is connected



### Pair with Your Device



Light Indicator	Status
 Blue light flashing quickly	Pairing mode
 Light off	Connected to a device

Navigate to your device's Bluetooth Settings, enable Bluetooth, and tap "Starry UFO" and pair

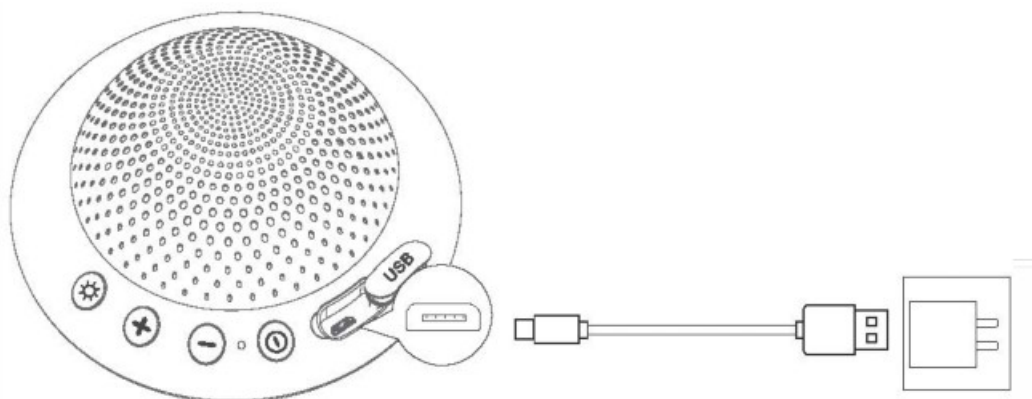




The speaker will automatically connect to the last connected device if available; otherwise, the speaker will enter pairing mode.

Have a connection problem? Remove "Starry UFO" from your device's Bluetooth Devices list, and ensure it's less than 1 meter away. Then try pairing again.



### Recharge the Speaker



Light Indicator	Status
 Steady red	Charging
 Light off	Fully charged



- When the speaker battery runs low, it will emit an alert tone.
- Use the included charging cable to charge the speaker.  
Make sure it is fully charged before first use.
- Disconnect your speaker from your charger when fully charged. Do not charge your speaker for extended periods.



## Wireless Hands-Free Speakerphone

The hands-free speakerphone feature works over Bluetooth with Bluetooth-enabled smartphones only.

1. Short press the power button to answer an incoming call or to end a call
2. Long press the power button for 2 seconds to reject an incoming call














Please keep the speaker close in front of you so you may be heard clearly by the listener  
You can use your smartphone to switch between using a Hands-free speakerphone and your phone












## Lighting Control

The Stany UFO Bluetooth speaker features 6 lighting settings.  
Turn the speaker on and the RGB light will flash red, green, and blue slowly.

Short press  to cycle through lighting settings or turn the light on or off:

			Flash red, green, and blue slowly
			– Steady red
			– Steady green
			– Steady blue
			Flash red, green, blue, and colorful quickly
			Flash blue, green, red, and colorful quickly
			RGB light off
			Button Control

 Double press	Disconnect device
 Short press	Pause/Play
– Short press	Volume down
+ Short press	Volume up
– long press	Last track
+ Long press	Next track

## ATTENTION

Close the waterproof rubber cover completely before putting the speaker in to the water.

To preserve battery lifespan, fully charge it at least once every month.

Avoid extreme temperatures (such as high heat fire and direct sunlight). Excessive heat or extreme cold temperatures may damage the battery.

Do not charge near the water source or in the rain to avoid electric shock.

Keep the speaker away from heat sources (including all equipment that generates heat), such as stoves, engines.

Do not use any corrosive cleaner/oil to clean.

## RESET THE SPEAKER

If the speaker is stuck, press and hold the power button for 10 seconds, then release the button, the speaker now has been reset.
