



Operation



- 1. Fetch the mouse and insert one AA battery into the battery compartment in the right direction;
- 2. Fetch the USB receiver from the battery compartment at the bottom of the mouse and plug it into the USB port of the computer.
- 3. It begins to serve when the system installs driver automatically.

FCC Statement
