# **Replacing Batteries**


To replace the batteries, follow these steps:

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the product.
- 2. Open the compartment cover using the provided instructions.
- 3. Remove the old batteries and dispose of them properly.
- 4. Insert the new AG13 batteries in the correct orientation as indicated.
- 5. Close the compartment securely.

- Q: What type of batteries does the Front End Loader require?
  - A: The Front End Loader requires 3 x AG13 (1.5V) batteries which are included with the product.


## **FUNCTIONS**



Push the handle back and forth to move the front bucket up and down.

**WARNING:** This product contains Button Cell Batteries. Button batteries are hazardous and can cause serious injuries if swallowed or placed inside any part of the body. Keep batteries away from children whether new or used. Dispose of used batteries immediately. If you think that batteries might have been swallowed or placed inside any part of the body, seek immediate medical attention.

## **REPLACING BATTERIES**



#### **WARNING**

## **BATTERY ADVICE**

Requires 3 X AG13 (1.5V). Batteries included. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity (+ and -). Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.


#### **ATTENTION**
