SETUP GUIDE

- Carefully take the yo-yo out of the box so you don't damage the string or body.
- Check String Length: Make sure the user's height doesn't interfere with the string length so it's easy to handle.
- Tie Finger Loop: Make a small loop at the end of the string to keep your grip tight while you play.
- Check the Axle and String: Before you start, make sure the string is wound around the axle properly.
- Test the LED Lights: Gently spin the yo-yo to see if the LED lights work.
- Practice Simple Throws: To get used to the yo-yo's weight and spin, start with simple throws.
- Get Good at Simple Tricks: Learn easy tricks like "Sleeper" to feel more comfortable with the yo-yo.
- Fine-Tune Spin: Change the throw position to get the longest spin times.
- Adjust String Tension: To keep the strings from getting tangled, keep the tension at the right level.
- Master Returns: You can make things go more smoothly if you practice controlled returns to the hand.
- Explore Looping Tricks: Learn looping tricks to get the most out of the yo-yo's design.
- Light Up the Play Area: Play with the yo-yo in a poorly lit area to enjoy the magic of the LED lights.

- Put the yo-yo away in a dry, safe place after use. Make sure the string is nicely wound up.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Wipe the string often to get rid of dirt and other things that are stuck on it.
- Change Worn Strings: If the string starts to fray or lose its tightness, you should get a new one.
- Keep Out of Water: To protect the LED lights and other parts inside the yo-yo, don't put it in water.
- Check the Axle: Look for dirt or dust on the ball-bearing axle and gently clean it if you find any.
- Tighten Loose Parts: To keep the yo-yo stable, tighten the halves every so often.
- Do Not Over-Twist: Do not twist the yo-yo too much because it could damage the axle or threads.
- Protect the LEDs: To keep the LED parts from breaking, don't drop the yo-yo on hard surfaces.
- Place to Store Coolly: To keep the yo-yo in good shape, keep it somewhere dry and cool.
- The body should be dusted with a soft cloth so that it doesn't get scratched.
- Avoid Too Much Impact: Be careful when handling the yo-yo to make it last longer.
- Check Spin Smoothness: Check the yo-yo's spin on a regular basis to find any problems with how it works.
- Check the brightness of the LEDs: If the lights get dim, make sure the yo-yo is put together correctly and cleaned.
- Use on Clean Surfaces: Don't play with the yo-yo on surfaces that are dirty or rough, as they could hurt it.
- Learn the Right Ways to Do Things: To keep the string and frame from getting too stressed, use the right ways to play.
- Keep for Indoor Use: It's better to play inside so that you don't get as much wear and tear from the weather.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
LED lights not turning on	Dead batteries	Replace with new batteries.
Yo-yo not spinning smoothly	String tangling or worn out	Untangle or replace the string.
LED lights dimming	Low battery power	Replace batteries with fresh ones.
Difficulty in performing tricks	Incorrect yo-yo setup	Adjust tension or string length.
Yo-yo stops midway	Over-tightened string	Loosen string slightly.
Uneven spin	Dirty or damaged axle	Clean or replace the axle.
Yo-yo not returning properly	Insufficient string tension	Tighten the string slightly.
Poor performance after drop	Misaligned yo-yo halves	Align the yo-yo halves correctly.
String slipping off	Improper finger loop placement	Adjust and secure the finger loop.
Yo-yo string fraying	Excessive wear	Replace with a new string.
Difficulty controlling yo-yo	Incorrect hand positioning	Practice correct hand positioning.
Noisy operation	Axle or bearing needs lubrication	Apply a small amount of yo-yo lubricant.
Yo-yo unresponsive	Bearing stuck	Clean or replace the bearing.
LED flickering	Loose battery connection	Secure battery compartment tightly.
Yo-yo feels unbalanced	Unequal weight distribution	Check assembly and correct weight balance.
