Product Usage Instructions

Step 1: Allowing Installation from Unknown Sources

1. Go to the Settings on your Android device.
2. In the search field, type “Unknown” and tap on “Install unknown apps” in the Special app access section.
3. Find and tap on “File Manager” in the Install unknown apps list.
4. Enable the “Allow from this source” option.
5. Tick the checkbox next to “I’m aware of the possible risks, and assumed all possible consequences voluntarily.”
6. Tap “OK” to confirm.

Step 2: Downloading and Installing EdiSmart APP

7. Visit the Edimax website or use the following link to download the EdiSmart APP: [EdiSmart_V2.0.17.1019.apk](#)
8. Open the File Manager on your Android device after downloading the file.
9. Locate the downloaded EdiSmart APK file in the APKs folder.
10. Tap on the downloaded EdiSmart APK file.
11. Tap “Install” to start the installation of the EdiSmart app.
12. After the installation is complete, you can open the app by clicking on “Open” or the EdiSmart icon on the home screen.

Step 3: Disabling Allow from this Source for File Manager

13. Remember to disable the “Allow from this source” option for File Manager after installing the EdiSmart APP.

FAQ

Q1: How can I enable installation from unknown sources on my Android device?

A1: To enable installation from unknown sources, follow Step 1 in the product usage instructions above.

Q2: Where can I download the EdiSmart APP?

A2: You can download the EdiSmart APP from the Edimax website or by using the provided link in Step 2 of the product usage instructions above.

Q3: How do I open the EdiSmart app after installation?

A3: After the installation is complete, you can open the EdiSmart app by clicking on “Open” or the EdiSmart icon

on your Android device's home screen.

Q4: Why should I disable “Allow from this source” for File Manager?

A4: It is recommended to disable “Allow from this source” for File Manager after installing the EdiSmart APP to ensure the security of your device.

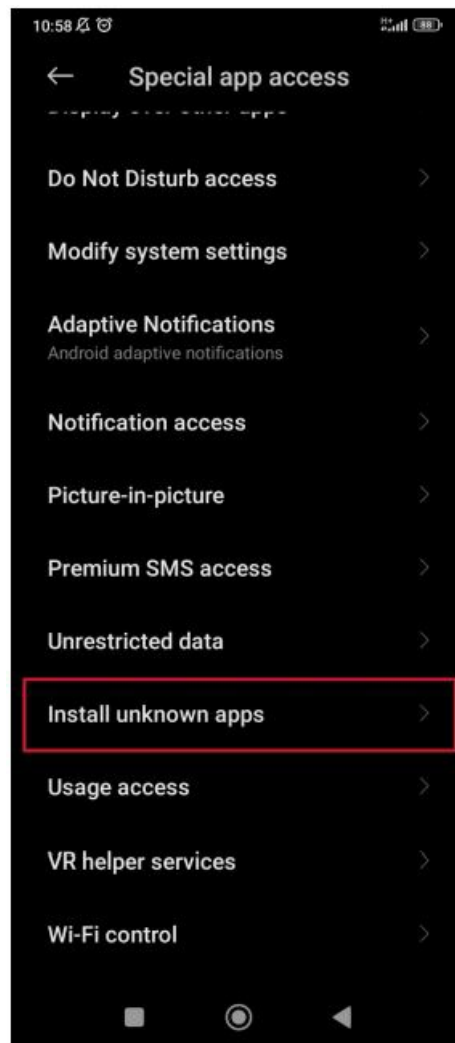
How to install EdiSmart Android APP

To install EdiSmart APP you need to allow install apps from unknown source first.

- To do that please go to Settings and in search field look for Unknown.
Tap Install unknown apps.



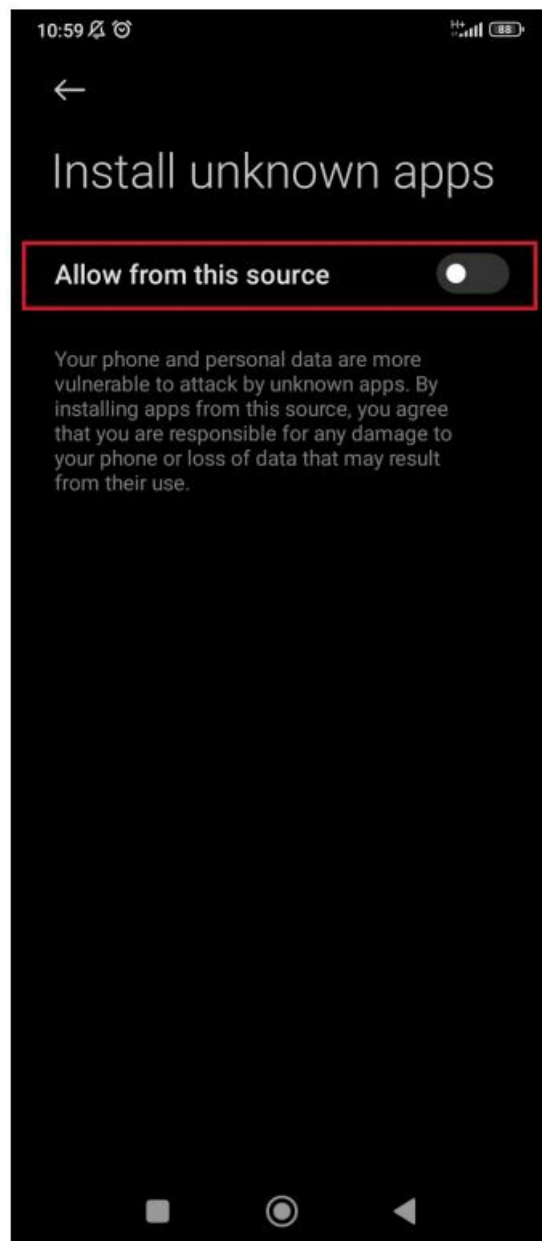
- In Special app access please find and tap Install unknown apps.



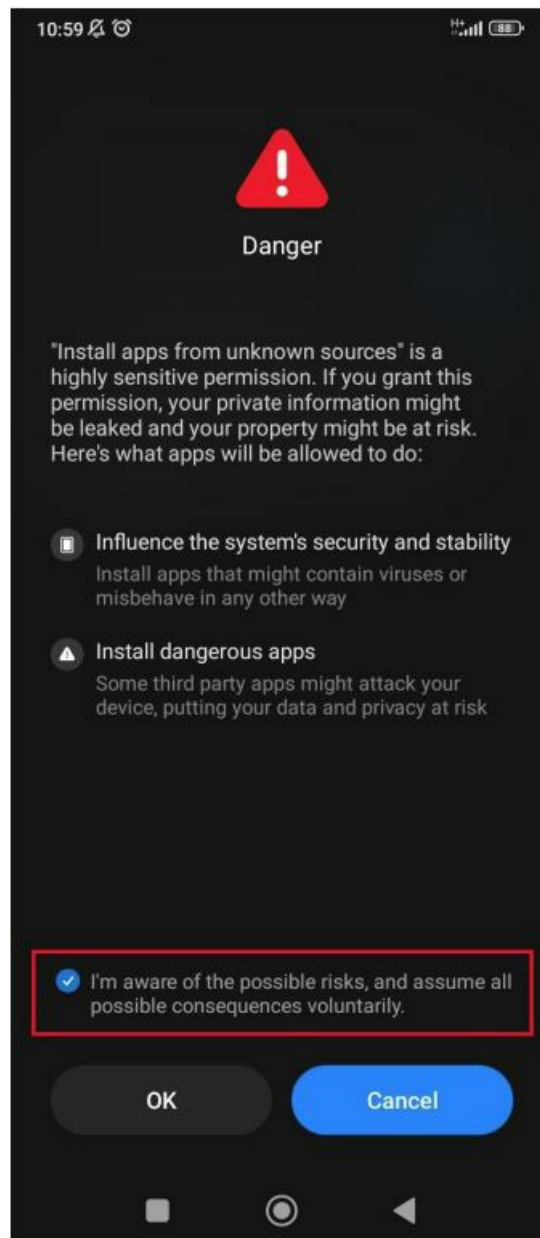
- In Install unknown apps please find and tap File Manager.



- Please enable Allow from this source.



- In order to allow installation of the APP from this source, please tick I'm aware of the possible risks, and assumed all possible consequences voluntarily. and then tap OK.

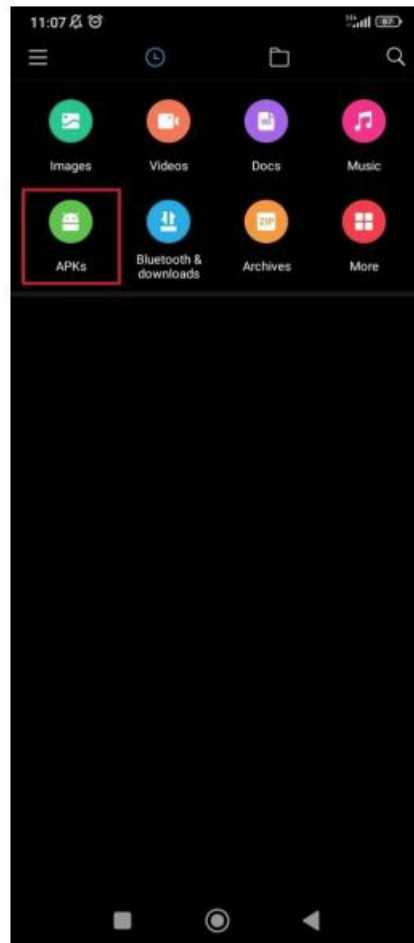


- Now you can download and install EdiSmart APP.

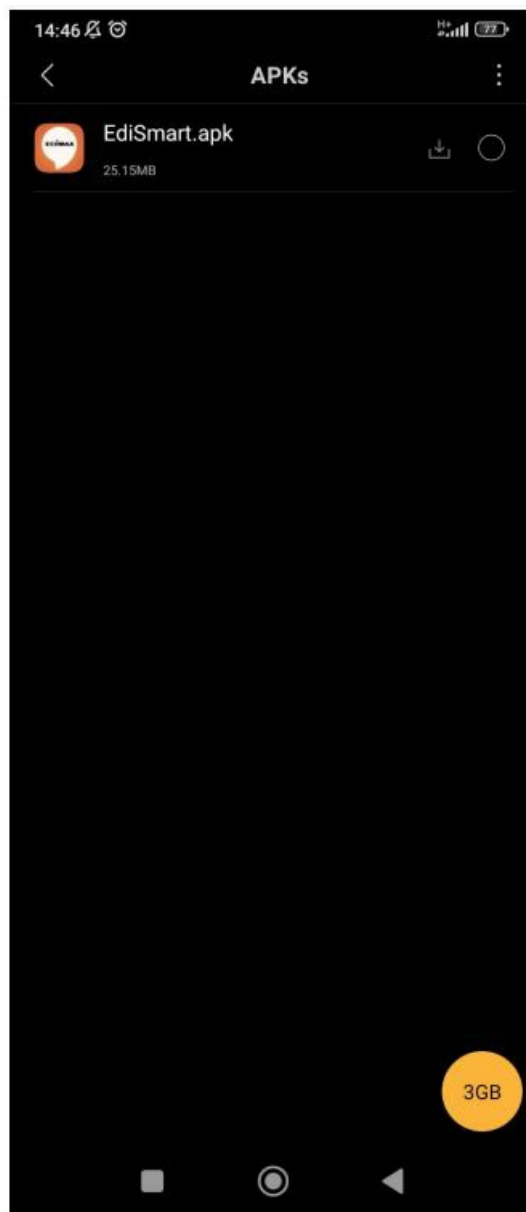


Please open File Manager after downloading the file. Downloaded EdiSmart APP can be found in APKs.

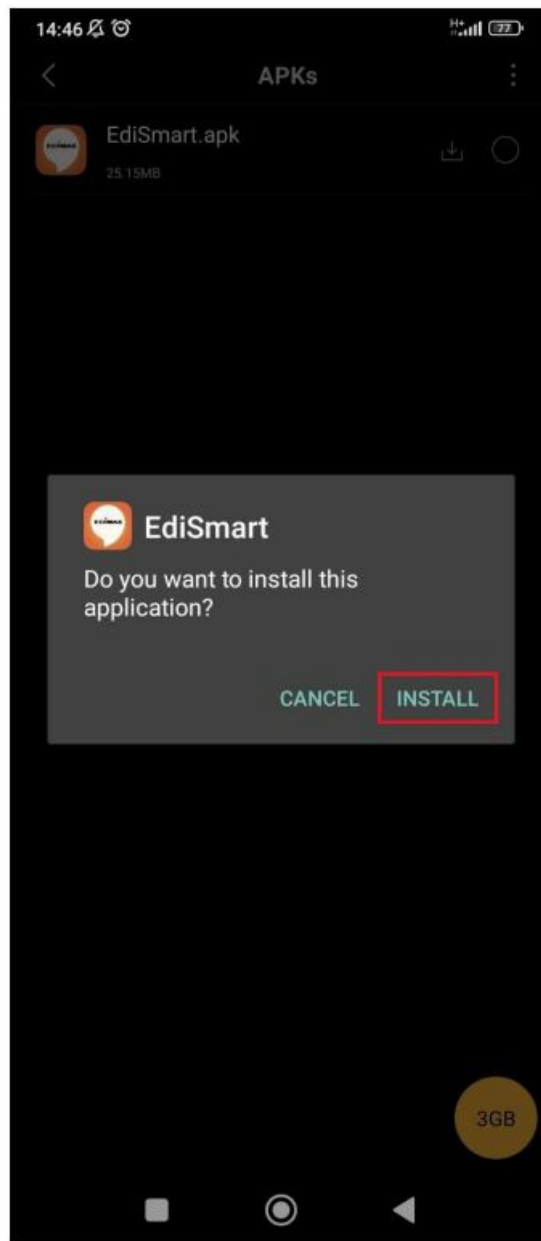
- Tap downloaded EdiSmart APK file.



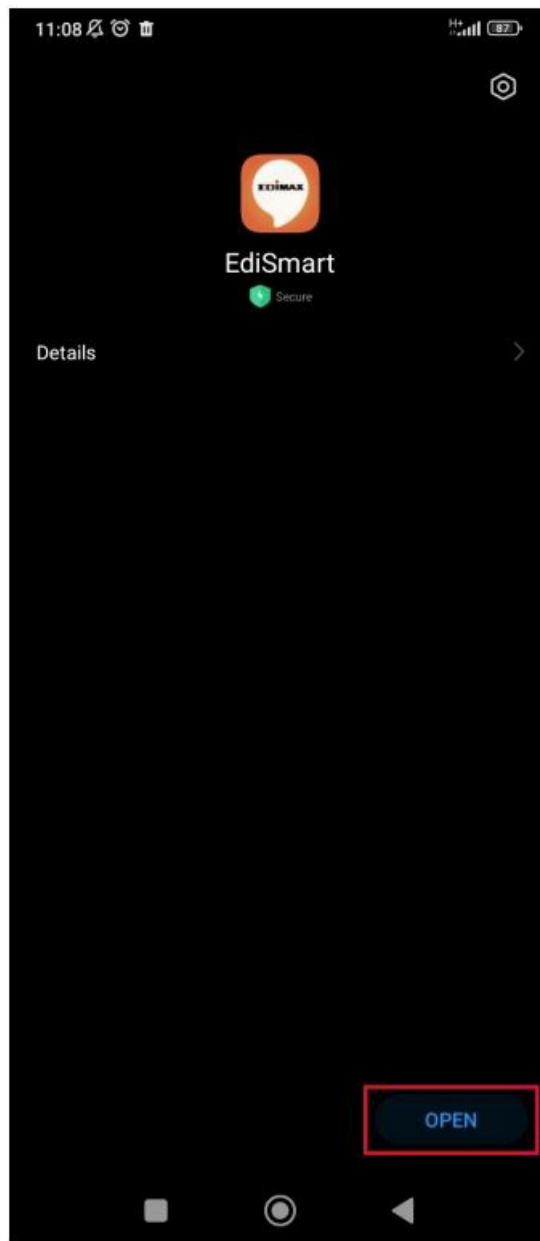
- Tap Install to install EdiSmart app.
