#### **Product Information**

#### **TE-RS 40 E Rotating Sander**

The TE-RS 40 E Rotating Sander is a powerful and versatile tool used for sanding and smoothing surfaces. It comes with a dust extraction system that collects dust directly through the sandpaper and sanding pad into the dust box. The tool has a maximum sound pressure level of 85 dB(A) and a sound power level of 96 dB(A). The vibration emission value of the handle is ah =  $10.1 \text{ m/s}^2$ . The device is powered by an electric cord and has a power consumption of 400 W.

## **Product Usage Instructions**

#### Before Use

Prior to using the TE-RS 40 E Rotating Sander, ensure that all safety precautions are taken into consideration. This includes wearing appropriate personal protective equipment such as safety glasses and a dust mask. It is also important to check that all packaging and transportation safety measures have been removed before use.

# Operation

# To operate the device, follow these steps:

- 1. Insert the sandpaper onto the sanding pad.
- 2. Connect the device to a power source using the power cord.
- 3. To switch on the device, push the operating switch forward.
- 4. To switch off the device, push the operating switch backward.

5. When sanding, apply gentle pressure to the surface being worked on, moving the device in a circular motion.

#### **Cleaning and Maintenance**

After each use, it is important to clean the device thoroughly. This includes emptying the dust box and wiping down the device with a dry cloth.

It is also important to check for any damage or wear and tear before using the device again.

#### **Disposal**

When disposing of the device, it is important to follow local regulations and guidelines. Do not dispose of the device with regular household waste.

#### **Service Information**

If you experience any issues with the TE-RS 40 E Rotating Sander, please refer to the troubleshooting section of the user manual or contact the manufacturer for assistance.

Remember to always read the operating instructions before using the device to reduce the risk of injury.

**Note:** Wear ear-muffs and a breathing mask when using the device to protect against noise and dust exposure. Do not use the device on materials containing asbestos.

- Caution Read the operating instructions to reduce the risk of inquiry
- Wear ear-muff s. The impact of noise can cause damage to hearing.
- Wear a breathing mask. Dust which is injurious to health can be generated when working on wood and other materials. Never use the device to work on any materials containing asbestos!
- Wear safety goggles. Sparks generated during working or splinters, chips and dust emitted by the de-vice can cause loss of sight.

When using the equipment, a few safety pre-cautions must be observed to avoid injuries and damage. Please read the complete operating instructions and safety regulations with due care. #### Items supplied

# Proper use

- The machine is designed for the grinding/san-ding of wood, metal, plastic and similar materials using the appropriate grinding/sanding paper. The equipment is not suitable for wet grinding/sanding.
- The equipment is to be used only for its prescri-bed purpose. Any other use is deemed to be a case of misuse. The user / operator and not the manufacturer will be liable for any damage or inju-ries of any kind caused as a result of this.
- Please note that our equipment has not been de-signed for use in commercial, trade or industrial applications.
   Our warranty will be voided if the machine is used in commercial, trade or industrial businesses or for equivalent purposes.

#### Sound and vibration

- Sound and vibration values were measured in accordance with EN 62841.
- LpA sound pressure level ...... 85 dB(A)
- KpA uncertainty ......3 dB
- LWA sound power level ...... 96 dB(A)
- KWA uncertainty ......3 dB

#### Wear ear-muffs.

- The impact of noise can cause damage to hearing.
- Total vibration values (vector sum of three directions) determined in accordance with EN 62841.

#### Handle

- Vibration emission value ah = 10.1 m/s2
- K uncertainty = 1.5 m/s2
- The stated vibration emission levels and stated noise emission values were measured in accordance with a set

of standardized criteria and can be used to compare one power tool with another.

• The stated vibration emission levels and stated noise emission values can also be used to make an initial assessment of exposure.

#### Warning:

• The vibration and noise emission levels may vary from the level specified during actual use, depending on the way in which the power tool is used, especially the type of workpiece it is used for.

## Keep the noise emissions and vibrations to a minimum.

- Only use appliances which are in perfect wor-king order.
- Service and clean the appliance regularly.
- Adapt your working style to suit the appliance.
- Do not overload the appliance.
- Have the appliance serviced whenever ne-cessary.
- Switch the appliance off when it is not in use.
- · Wear protective gloves.

#### Residual risks

Even if you use this electric power tool in accordance with instructions, certain resi-dual risks cannot be rules out. The following hazards may arise in connection with the equipment's construction and layout:

- 1. Lung damage if no suitable protective dust mask is used.
- 2. Damage to hearing if no suitable ear protection is used.
- 3. Health damage caused by hand-arm vibrations if the equipment is used over a pro-longed period or is not properly guided and maintained.

# Before starting the equipment


- Before you connect the equipment to the mains supply make sure that the data on the rating plate are identical to the mains data.
- Always pull the power plug before making adjustments to the equipment.

#### Fitting the additional handle (Fig. 2)



• Place the additional handle (7) on the equipment as shown in Fig. 2, insert the lock bolt through the hole and fasten it on the other side with the clam-ping screw (8).

## Fitting the dust collection box (Fig. 3)




- The dust collection box (6) must be pushed onto the connector for the dust collection box (5). Push the dust collection box (6) onto the equipment until you hear it click clearly. To remove the dust collection box (6), press the locking knob (9) and pull the dust collection box to the rear and off.
- The dust is extracted directly through the abrasive paper and the grinding/sanding disk into the dust bag.

# Important!

• For health safety reasons it is imperative that you use the dust collection box.


## Fastening the abrasive paper (Fig. 6)



• Easy replacement using hook-and-loop fastening. Ensure that the extractor holes on the abrasive paper and grinding/sanding disc line up.

# Operation

# Switching the equipment ON/OFF (Fig. 4)



#### To switch on:

• Push the ON/OFF switch (4) forwards.

#### To switch off:

• Push back the ON/OFF switch (4) into its starting position.

## Speed control (Fig. 5/Item 3)



• To pre-select the speed turn the knurled screw (3) on the switch.

Plus direction: Higher speedMinus direction: Lower speed

## Working with the eccentric grinder/sander

- Place the whole surface area of the sanding disk on the material.
- Switch on the machine and move it with gent-le pressure over the workpiece completely circular movements or moving it to and fro and up and down.

Use a coarse paper for coarse sanding and a finer paper for finish sanding. You can find the best paper for the
job by means of testing.

#### Important.

- The dust generated when working with the machi-ne may be harmful.
- Always wear goggles and a dust mask when carrying out sanding/grinding work.
- Everybody who uses the machine or enters the workplace must wear a dust mask.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke at the workplace.
- Do not use the machine on paints which con-tain lead.

# Replacing the power cable

• If the power cable for this equipment is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its after-sales service or similarly trained personnel to avoid danger.

# Cleaning, maintenance and ordering of spare parts

Always pull out the mains power plug before star-ting any cleaning work.

## Cleaning

- Keep all safety devices, air vents and the motor housing free of dirt and dust as far as possible. Wipe the equipment with a clean cloth or blow it with compressed air at low pressure.
- We recommend that you clean the device immediately each time you have finished using it.
- Clean the equipment regularly with a moist cloth and some soft soap. Do not use cleaning agents or solvents; these could attack the plastic parts of the equipment. Ensure that no water can seep into the device. The ingress of water into an electric tool increases the risk of an electric shock.

#### **Carbon Brushes**

• In case of excessive sparking, have the carbon brushes checked only by a qualifi ed electrician. Important! The carbon brushes should not be replaced by anyone but a qualifi ed electrician.

#### **Maintenance**

• There are no parts inside the equipment that require additional maintenance.

#### Disposal and recycling

• The equipment is supplied in packaging to prevent it from being damaged in transit. The raw materials in this packaging can be reused or recycled. #### **Storage**
