





Product Operations

Operation Diagram













Battery Level






Low Battery Indication








Charging Constantly red


Full The red light out


Volume Control FM and intercom can be used at the same time.

Intercom / Calling / Music / FM




When Intercom & FM use simultaneously, FM volume control






Factory Reset
