


**Operation Diagram** 






















### **Compatible with Old Intercom Pairing**

- 1. Long press< A Button> for 5s, while V4/V6 enter the pairing mode.
  - : Red and blue lights flash fast alternately

- "Intercom A Pairing"
- 2. Click < A Button> enter Bluetooth search mode.
  - : Red and blue lights flash twice alternatively
  - "Intercom A Searching"


# **Phone Pairing**





#### **Music Share**

Share the music played by Bluetooth on your phone to another device, and this function cannot be used during Bluetooth intercom. This function cannot be used when two phones are connected simultaneously.


- 1. Take an intercom as the host, connect it to the phone, and the other one is the slave.
- 2. Press the <Phone/Power Button>+<Volume -> at the same time between the host and slave to enter the music sharing search connection state. 

  "Music Share"





- 3. After the connection is successful play the phone music of the host, and the music can also be played from the speaker. Music Share Connected"
- 4. Press the <Phone/Power Button>+<Volume -> again to exit music sharing. "Music Share Disconnected"

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

- Q: Can I use the Music Share function during Bluetooth intercom?
   A: No, the Music Share function cannot be used simultaneously with Bluetooth intercom. It is designed to share music between devices when not engaged in intercom conversations.
- Q: Can I connect two phones at the same time for Music Share?
   A: No, the Music Share function does not support connecting two phones simultaneously. You can only pair one host device with one slave device for music sharing.
