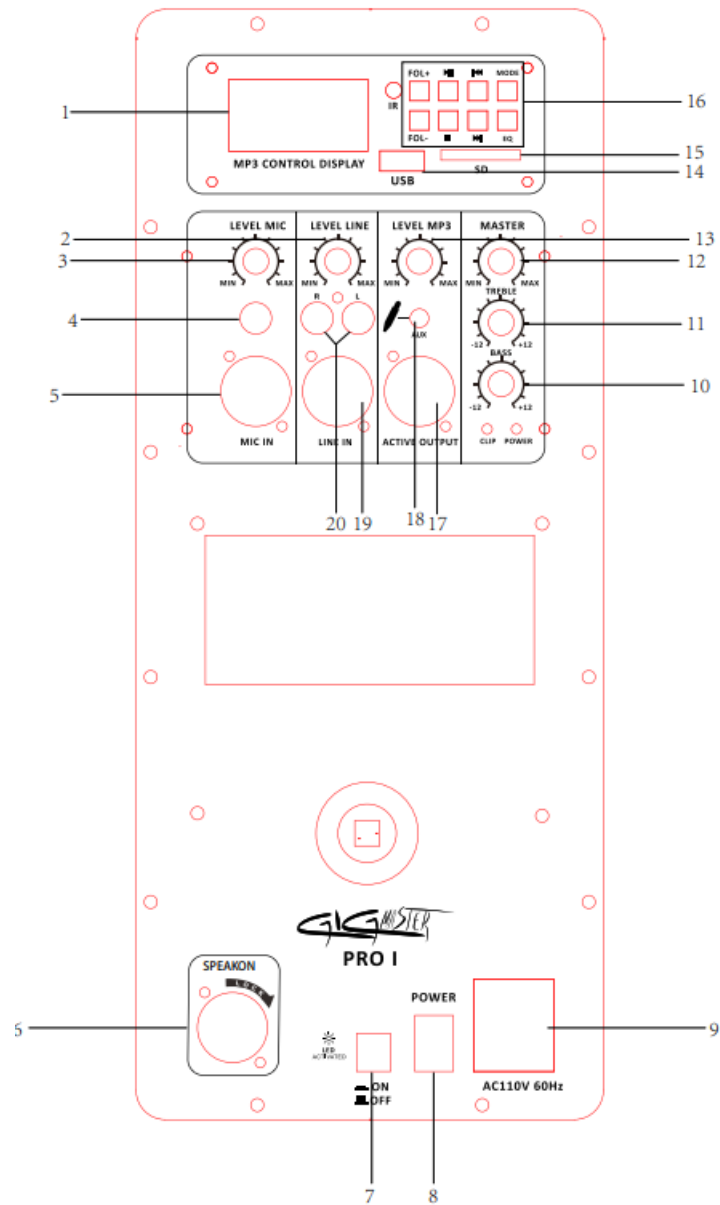

Overview



1. MP3 control display
2. Line level control
3. Mic level control
4. Mic input (Jack connector)
5. Mic input(XLR connector)
6. Speakon
7. LED control
8. Power switch
9. Power plug
10. Bass dB level control
11. Treble dB level control
12. Master volume control
13. .MP3 level control
14. .USB input
15. SD card input
16. Play/Pause/Scan/Reception/Auterior/Silent

OPERATION

1. Prior to switching on, turn volume down to a minimum.
2. Connect the audio source to the appropriate Input socket.
3. Another Speaker can be connected to the output socket, so that several boxes can be daisy-chained.
4. Connect to the mains supply.
5. Switch on the audio source, followed by the active speaker.
6. Set the volume with the applicable control.
7. Adjust the bass+treble.
8. Activate the Bluetooth:Input password"0000"if ask for.


