

- Connect EL-DP-30A to the Internet via WiFi or LAN. Settings -> I letwork II Internet -> WiFi -> select desirect
 SSID and enter password
- 4. Pair optional peripheral devices via BT. Settings -> Connected devices -> Bluetooth -> Pair new device (and refer to your BT device for pairing instructions)

Polls

- 1. Power Port: Connect the AC Power Adapter to this port. Then, plug the AC Power Adapter into a grounded AC power outlet.
- 2. Hot in use.


