

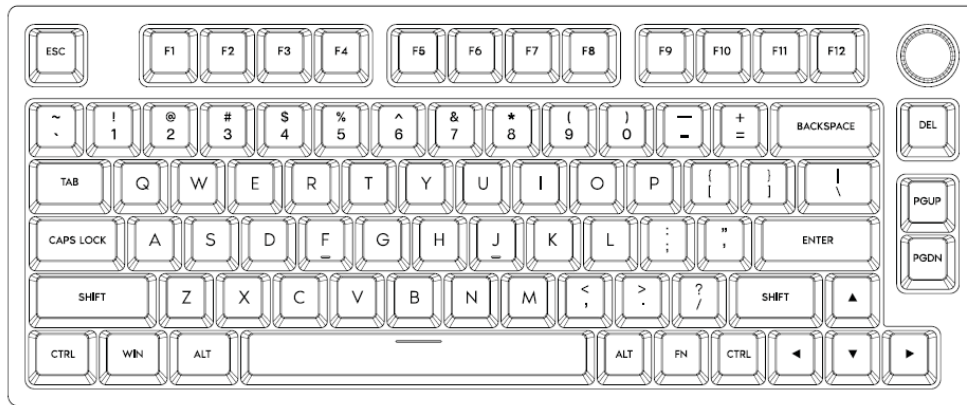

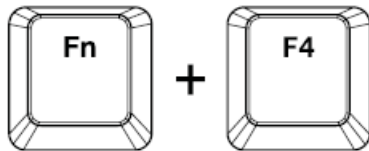

Pressing FN+ \ at the same time allows you to switch the RGB effect of your THBO Keyboard.

PAIRING BLUE T OOTH

FN +11213 : Long Press for 3 seconds

Long press the FN+ 1/2/3 for 3 seconds, the keyboard will start pairing and the light will flash. If there's no connection, the keyboard will enter into sleep mode.

PAIRING WIR ELESS 2.4GHz

FN+4 : Switch to Wireless Mode and then press ...

FN+TAB : Long Press for 3 seconds

Turn on the keyboard. Press FN+4 to enter the 2.4G mode, then press the FN+ TAB for 3 seconds to enter the pairing mode. Insert the receiver, you will see the light flashes. After a successful connection, the light will stay on for 10 seconds. If there's no connection in 30 seconds, the keyboard will stop paring and enter into sleep mode.

The product's Bluetooth function is compatible with the mainstream Bluetooth dongles and notebooks' built-in Bluetooth.

To use Bluetooth 5.0, the connected device should support Windows 8 systems or above. If the connected device is a smartphone or tablet, the device (smartphone or tablet) needs to support Bluetooth 5.0.

WIRELESS 2.4GHz SPECIFICATIONS

In accordance with the USB standard protocol.

This mode is compatible with Windows 2000 or above and MAC operating system.

KEYBOARD WAKE UP/SLEEP

- If your keyboard is sleeping press any key to wake it up, it will remember the last device connected.

- **Wireless 2.4GHz**

When you turn your keyboard on a green light will show to tell you wireless has properly connected.

If the keyboard shows no signs of working in your device try pairing it again by repeating the steps indicated in the Wireless 2.4GHz Pairing Instructions.

- **Bluetooth**

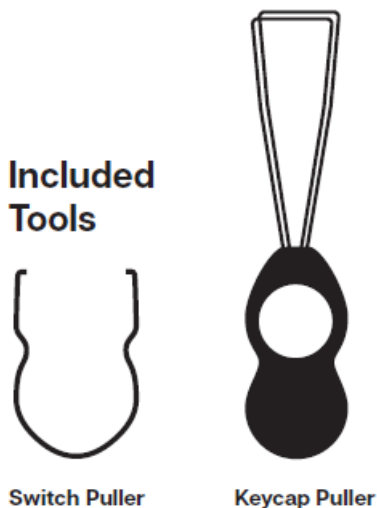
When you turn your keyboard on a blue light will show to tell you bluetooth has properly connected to the last device (1 2 or 3). If the keyboard shows no signs of working in your device try pairing it again by repeating the steps indicated in the Bluetooth Pairing Instructions.

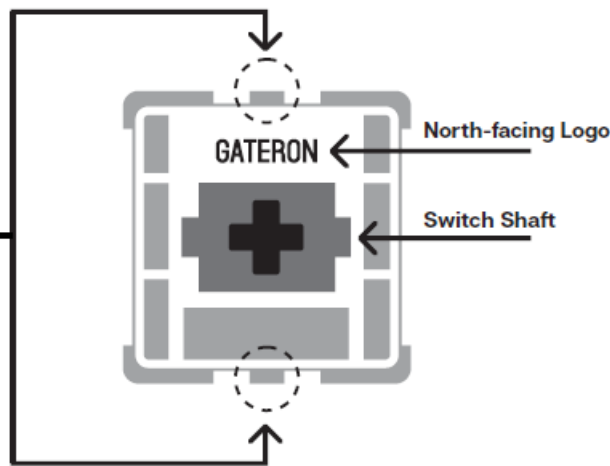


Remove Switches

1. Grab your Switch Removal Tool and align the gripping teeth vertically (on the Y- Axis) at the center of the switch, as shown in the example graphic above.
2. Grab the switch with the Switch Puller and apply pressure until the switch releases itself from the plate.
3. Using firm but gentle force pull the switch away from the keyboard using a vertical motion.

Mechanical Switch

Example of a switch as seen from top after you remove the keycap to prepare for switch removal.



The Switch Puller tool aligns Vertically to the Switch to unclip the plastic securing the switch to the plate.

Install Switches

- Check that all the switch metallic pins are perfectly straight and clean.
- Align the switch vertically to have the Gateron logo facing north. The pins should align themselves to the keyboard PBC.
- Press the switch down until you hear a click. This means your switch clips have attached themselves to the keyboard plate.
- Inspect the switch to ensure it's properly attached to your keyboard, and test it.

Note: If the key doesn't work its possible you may have bent one of the switches while installing it. Pull the switch out and repeat the process.

Pins may be damaged beyond repair and need replacement if this process is not done correctly. Never apply excessive force when replacing keycaps or switches. If you cannot remove or install keycaps or switches please contact customer service as soon as possible to avoid damage to the keyboard due to operating errors.
