Installation Instructions

Step 1: Preparation

Turn off the computer and disconnect the power cable to avoid any electrical hazards.



Step 2: Access FDD Slots

Refer to your computer manual to open the case and locate the FDD slots.



Step 3: Mounting the FDD

Mount the EPSON SD-880 FDD in either the upper or lower slot using four screws, ensuring the bezel is flush with the front of the PC.



Step 4: Jumper Configuration

Refer to the jumper settings to configure the FDD based on your requirements. Make changes with caution when the computer is off and unplugged.



Step 5: Cable Connection

Attach the 4-pin power cable and the 34-pin edge connector to the rear of the FDD, aligning pin 1 to the left with the cable connector.

Jumper Configurations

Refer to the provided diagram for detailed jumper configurations for drive select and mode change settings.

FAQ

Q: How do I determine which drive (3.5" or 5.25") is set as Drive A or Drive B?

A: The jumper settings (SS1) determine which drive is assigned as Drive A or Drive B. In the default position (A), Drive A is set as the 3.5" FDD if the dual drive is in the upper slot and uses the end FDD connector on the cable.
