Product Information

The product is a cart with drawers and a worksurface designed for use in various settings. The cart has a weight capacity of 2 lbs (1 kg) per drawer and a maximum listed weight capacity that should not be exceeded to avoid serious injury or property damage. The cart also has moving parts that can crush and cut, posing a risk for serious personal injury or property damage if not handled properly. The product comes with a user's guide that provides important information on safety hazards and how to avoid them. The user's guide also contains contact information for Ergotron Customer Care for further assistance.

Product Usage Instructions

Before using the cart, it is important to review the safety hazards and symbols provided in the user's guide to avoid accidents and injuries. Children who are not able to recognize and respond appropriately to Safety Alerts should not use this product without adult supervision.

When using the cart, it is important to:

- Close the worksurface before opening the drawers.
- · Open only one drawer at a time.
- Do not push the cart when drawers or worksurface are open to avoid instability.
- Avoid exceeding the maximum listed weight capacity to avoid serious injury or property damage.


Hazard Symbols Review


Components




- This manual covers the installation of 5 possible drawers.
- There is only 1 drawer provided in this box.




1. Remove the top cover.




2. Hang the drawer tabs onto the brackets on the cart.




3. Replace top cover on drawer.




4. To unlock the storage drawer, turn-key counterclockwise $1/4\ turn$.



Adjust your mounting solution to handle the added weight. Adjustments should move smoothly and easily through the full range of motion and stay where you set it. If adjustments are difficult and do not stay in the desired position, follow the instructions to loosen or tighten the tension to create a smooth, easy adjustment motion. Depending on your product and the adjustment, it may take several turns to notice a difference.







NOTE: Adjustment may require 40 – 60 revolutions.
