



Open the battery compartment cover on the the back side.




Insert ONE CR2032 3V batteries in correct polarity .Do not mix old or used batteries with new

Close the cover.


Point the remote towards the remote control sensor of the wireless monitor and use it within 7 meters.



Put the used batteries into the recycling bin since it can negatively affect the environment.




BNC INPUT and BNC OUTPUT Connection



- Connect the BNC in cable output of the PROCESSOR to the BNC input on the set.
- Connect the BNC out cable input of the other monitor to the BNC output on the set.
- Select BNC1 or BNC2 input source with using the INPUT button on the remote control.

PC Connection

This CCTV monitor provides plug and play capability, meaning that the PC adjusts automatically to the monitor's setting. The CCTV monitor sends configuration information (EDID) to the PC using the Video Electronics Standard Association (VESA) Display Data Channel (DDC) protocol.

Turn on monitor


- Connect the AC input cable to monitor, then press the main power switch on monitor. At this time the monitor will enter into standby mode and the indicator light turn red.
- Using buttons can turn on monitor from standby mode as follows:
 Press POWER keyon front panel or on the remote control.

Turn off monitor

- Press POWER button on front panel the or on the remote control to enter standby mode. The indicator light is red.
- Using main power switch turns off monitor completely.

Selecting screen language

NOTE:If you use your monitor for the first time, you should select the language which will be used for displaying menus and indications.



- Press the "MENU" button into main menu.
- Press the "

 " button toselect OSD menu.
- Press the "YA" button to select OSD LANGUAGE.

- Press the "

Maintenance

Early manifuctions can be prevented. Careful and regular cleaning can extend the amount of time in that way, you will have a new one. Be sure to turn the power off and unplug the power cord before you begin any cleaning.

Cleaning the screen

Here's a great way to keep the dust off screen for a while. Wet soft cloth in a mixture of lukewarm water and a little fabric softener or dish washing detergent. Wring the cloth until it's almost dry, and then used it to wipe the screen. Make sure the remained water is off the screen, and then let it air-dry before you turn on your monitor.

Cleaning the cabinet

To remove dirt or dust, wipe the cabinet with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Please be sure not to use a wet cloth.

Extended Absence

If you expect to leave your monitor dormant for a long time (such as a vacation), A is a goodidea to une yug the poer cord to it from lightning or powe surges.

FAQ

Q: How do I adjust the sound settings on the monitor?

A: To adjust sound settings, follow these steps:

- 1. Press the corresponding button to select the Sound menu.
- 2. Use the navigation buttons to select the setting you want to adjust (e.g., Bass, Treble, Balance).
- 3. Press the button to make adjustments.
- 4. Once satisfied, press MENU to exit the main menu.

Q: How do I change the aspect ratio on the monitor?

A: To change the aspect ratio, follow these steps:

- 1. Select the Picture menu using the designated button.
- 2. Use the navigation buttons to choose the desired aspect ratio option.
- 3. Press the button to confirm your selection.
- 4. Press MENU to exit the main menu once adjustments are complete.
