Device Description

The Swift Commode is a shower commode chair with detachable armrests and backrests. It can be used as a stand-alone toilet, over the toilet, or in the shower. The height of the chair is adjustable, and it can be used with one, two, or without arm supports. The opening in the chair enables a stable grip and support when the arm supports are not used.

Intended Purpose

The Swift Commode is a medical device designed to alleviate or compensate for functional impairments due to injury or disability. It is intended for performing hygiene tasks in the shower, at a sink, or over the toilet, as well as for transfers to and from the hygiene room.

Intended User Group

The Swift Commode is suitable for individuals with a height of 146 cm (57.5 inches) or more, or a mass of 40 kg (88 lbs) or more. The user group is based on functional ability rather than a specific diagnosis, health condition, or age. Caregivers providing assistance and clinicians/technicians who set up the device can also be secondary users.

Intended Environment

The Swift Commode is intended for indoor use in home environments or institutions. It is suitable for use in bathrooms.

but not in swimming pools or similar corrosive environments.

Intended Application

The Swift Commode is designed for both short-term and long-term use. It can be applied multiple times per day for hygiene tasks and transfers.

FAQ

Q: Can the armrests and backrest be detached?

A: Yes, the Swift Commode comes with detachable armrests and backrest for easy customization and use.

Q: What is the weight capacity of the Swift Commode?

A: The maximum user weight for the Swift Commode is 160 kg (352 lbs).

Q: Can the Swift Commode be used in swimming pools?

A: No, the Swift Commode is not suitable for use in swimming pools or similar corrosive environments.

Device description

Swift Commode is a shower commode chair with detachable armrests and backrests. It is height adjustable to be used as a stand-alone toilet, over the toilet or in the shower. It can be used with one, two or without arm supports. If the arm supports are not used, the opening enables a stable grip and support.

Intended purpose

Swift Commode (hereafter also referred to as "the device" or "the product"), is a medical device intended for alleviation of or compensation for a functional impairment due to an injury or disability. The device is designed to be used when performing hygiene tasks in the shower, at a sink, or over the toilet, as well as for transfers to and from the hygiene room.

Intended user group

The user group for the device is based on the individual's functional ability and not on a specific diagnosis, health condition or age. They are intended for individuals with a height of 146 cm or more, or a mass of 40 kg or more. Secondary users of the devices are caregivers providing assistance and clinicians/technicians who set up the device.

Intended environment

The device is intended for indoor use at home environments or institutions and are suitable for use in bathrooms, but not swimming pools or similar corrosive environments.

Intended application

The device is intended for short-term and long-term use and can be applied several times per day. The device is intended for use with intact skin. The device is intended for refurbishment and reuse.

Expected service life

The expected service life is 7 years. For complete information regarding the service life of the device, see www.etac.com.

Indications

Indication for use is a disability, including, but not limited to, an individual with physical disabilities who needs a backrest and/or armrests to maintain a sitting position and assistance with transfers to/from the chair.

Contraindications:

There are no known contraindications.

- Check user sensitivity for pressure ulcer before use
- A defective device must not be used.
- When moving sideways, do not lean on just one armrest.






- 1. Back support

Maintenance

- Clean the device with a solvent-free detergent which has a pH of 5-9, or with a 70% disinfectant solution. Can be decontaminated at max. 85°C if so required.
- Constituent materials are corrosion-resistant. 5-year guarantee against material and manufacturing defects. For terms and conditions, see www.etac.com.

Storage

The device should be stored indoors in a dry place at a temperature above 5°C. If the device has been stored for a long time (more than four months), its function must be checked by an expert before use.
