




Secondary functions

Note: The tab keys and capslock will blink 3 times when the minimum or maximum value of the LED speed or LED brightness is reached.

Magic FN



The magic key can copy the Function keys that gives you a quick access to your media player, custom function etc. By using FN+Caps lock key, you get a quick access to multimedia key, home page, custom function, etc.

Note: The FN keys will light white LED when magic FN is ON

Device

In this bar you can customize your keyboard keys using these two options, APP mode and On-board editor.



APP mode

- * Select each key for function replacement.
- * You can choose either remap key, macro, multimedia keys, and etc.
- * After choosing your desire function, then press OK.

Note: In app mode, the function of button customization can only be used when the app is opened. The customized content can only be saved on the computer and it does not support downloading to the keyboard.



On-board Editor

- * Select each key for function replacement.
- * You can choose either remap key, macro, multimedia keys, and etc.
- * After choosing your desire function, then press OK.

Note: In on-board editing mode, the interactive light effect is invalid. The key can be downloaded and saved to the keyboard according to the customized content. The board can be divided into two layers, the default layer and the FN1 layer.

Default layer: Press the key directly to send the code.

FN1 layer: Select a key and set it to FN1 then send the code by combining with custom FN1 key



Lighting

- * You can select up to 16 preset illumination modes.
- * Some of illumination modes, you can customize the speed and the brightness



Macro


- * To make a new macro, select macro bar then add the macro key in the macro group section and then input the action.
- * The command recording will start just after you press the record button, you can choose the recording delay.
- * To save, press stop button to save your macro.
- * You can modify the macro recording, by selecting the action input in the macro record section, either you can input more macro action, or you can change the key that you want in the property section, then press modify.

Note: You can only input a max of 20 actions.

How to use


Change switches and keycaps

1. Remove keycap




Use the Keycap puller tool to clamp on a keycap and pull upward, to detach keycap from switch. Sometimes the switch may come out as well if the keycap is secured tightly on switch, which is normal. For longer keys such as the space bar, always clamp and remove from the MIDDLE of the keycap.

2. Remove switch



Use the switch puller to push in the two tabs located on the top and bottom side of the switch. Once they are pushed in, pull upwards to remove switch from keyboard case. Warning: It is very easy to scratch your keyboard case with lilies tool, so take caution when removing switches!


3. Insert switch



When inserting a new switch, align switch to holes on the keyboard, and insert straight down. There should be minimal resistance and the switch should pop into the frame of the keyboard. It is recommended at this time to have a Notepad ready on your PC, open it and make sure the switch works twice you press it. If the switch does not light up, or the key doesn't show up on your PC when you press it, then the switch was not inserted properly. Remove switch, and make sure pins are straight then insert ongoing.


• Note: It is safe to swap switches while your keyboard is plugged in to your PC

4. Insert keycap




Once you have confirmed the switch was properly inserted, snap back in the appropriate keycap.

How to connect




Plug in the Type-C cable to the keyboard.



Connect the keyboard to computer by inserting USB jack to your computer USB port.
