Fanvil CS40 Conferencing Speakerphone



Safety warning

Please read and follow all safety and operation instructions before using this product.

- The devices contain small parts that may pose a choking hazard to children. Ensure that young children are kept away from these parts.
- Do not use the device near water or in moist environments to prevent the risk of electric shock or damage to the device.
- Avoid using them in extreme temperatures or dusty environments.
- Avoid dropping the device or subjecting them to strong impacts. Handle with care to prevent damage.
- For headset, avoid listening at high volumes for extended periods to prevent hearing damage.
- When using headset, be aware of your surroundings. Do not use them while driving, cycling, or in any situation where not hearing external sounds could be dangerous.
- Avoid using these devices near strong electromagnetic sources, such as microwave ovens or large speakers, as they may cause interference or reduce sound quality.
- Store the devices in a cool, dry place when not in use. Avoid leaving them in direct sunlight or high temperatures, such as in a car on a hot day.

Battery Warning
