#### **General Instructions**

It is important to be aware that the product may contain small parts that are not safe for children. To prevent choking hazards, always keep the device and its components out of reach of children. During use, make sure the device has proper ventilation to prevent overheating by not blocking any vents or air inlets, and avoid placing the device on soft surfaces that may obstruct airflow. Keep in mind that this product is not designed or intended to be used as medical equipment, and should not be used to diagnose, treat, or monitor any medical conditions. Do not attempt to repair or dismantle the device, as unauthorized modifications or repairs may void the warranty and pose safety risks. Contact TUO Accessories customer support for assistance if needed. Unless specifically mentioned, this product is not designed for outdoor use, so protect it from moisture and direct sunlight to prevent damage.

# **Powering the Device**

Before handling the device, make sure your hands are clean and dry. Plug the power cord into a grounded outlet with the appropriate voltage for your region. It is important to ensure that the power cord is not tangled or damaged. Replace the cord immediately if there are any visible signs of wear or damage. To minimize the risk of electrical issues, avoid using extension cords or power strips when powering the device.

#### **Battery-Powered Operation**

When operating your TUO Accessories device on battery power, use only the recommended battery types. Be sure to insert the batteries with the correct polarity (+/-) as indicated on the device. If the device will not be in use for an extended period, remove the batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types, as this can lead to poor performance and potential safety hazards.

#### Maintenance and Cleaning

To clean your device, first unplug it and remove the batteries. Gently wipe the exterior with a soft, slightly damp cloth.
