



Button Description





ANC Mode

ANC Mode: short press " to switch the ANC Mode, voice prompts "ANC Mode"

Low Latency Mode

- Press" for five times to enter the low latency game mode, voice prompts "Game Mode"
- Press" for five times again to switch the music mode, voice prompts "Music Mode"

Bluetooth Mode

Bluetooth pairing: long press" "for three seconds, voice prompts "power on" to start up the Bluetooth headphone, it will enter pairing mode automatically, voice prompts "Bluetooth Mode", indicator light flashes with white and orange. Turn on the smart device's Bluetooth searching function and select the device "Roam", no password is required, after successfully pairing, a tone "Connected" will be heard, the LED indicator light flashes white slowly. Clean pairing: long press the "+" and "-" for 3s at the same

time to clean the original pair of connected devices.

Button Description:

- 1. Play/pause the music: short press" "to play or pause the music
- 2. Last/next song: long press "+"for 2 seconds to the next song; long press" "for 2 seconds to the previous song
- 3. Volume control: short press "+" for increasing volume, short press" " for reducing volume
- 4. Voice assistance: triple press" "to activate the voice assistance
- 5. Answer the call: short press "when calls coming"
- 6. End of the call: short press " when calls ending
- 7. Reject the call: long press " for 2 seconds when calls coming
- 8. Power off: long press "for 3 seconds to turn off the headphone"

LED Indicator Light Status

Charging Status	LED is orange when charging, turns off when fully charged.
Pairing Status	LED flashes white and orange.
Playing Status	LED turns off.
