


INSTRUCTIONS

- Keep these instructions for future reference as they contain important information.
- Battery installation is required. Only adults should install batteries. Required tool: Phillips screwdriver (not included).
- Requires two AAA batteries (included) for operation. The batteries included are for demonstration purposes only. For longer life, use alkaline batteries.
- Press a button to hear numbers, fun sounds, phrases, and songs.



• Locate the battery compartment door. Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the batteries and properly dispose.



- Insert two, new AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw. Do not over-tighten.
- When sounds/lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries.
- Wipe the toy with a clean, damp cloth. Do not immerse. This toy has no consumer-serviceable parts. Do not take it apart.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Remove the batteries and reinstall them.

Battery Safety Information

In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the product dimensions of the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone?

The Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone measures 1.02 x 2.76 x 4.96 inches.

What is the weight of the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone?

The Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone weighs 5.6 ounces.

What age range is recommended for the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone?

The Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone is recommended for children aged 6 months to 3 years.

What type of batteries does the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone require?

The Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone requires 2 AAA batteries.

What should I do if the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone does not turn on?

Ensure the 2 AAA batteries are properly installed and not depleted. If the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone still does not turn on, try replacing the batteries with new ones.

How can I fix the issue if the lights on the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone are not working?

Verify that the batteries are correctly installed and have sufficient charge. If the lights still do not work, try replacing the batteries with new ones.

What steps should I take if the sound on the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone is too low or distorted?

Check the battery level and replace the batteries if necessary. Low battery power can cause sound issues in the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone.

How can I reset the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone if it freezes or becomes unresponsive?

Ensure the touch-sensitive areas are clean and free from debris. If the problem persists, try resetting the device by removing and reinserting the batteries.

How can I resolve issues with the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone not switching between modes?

Turn off the Fisher-Price BFK69 Laugh & Learn Smart Phone, remove the batteries, and wait a few minutes before reinserting them. This can help reset the mode settings and resolve the issue.
