- This user manual will help you operate it, please read carefully before use.
- The 302 is a portable Bluetooth speaker that connects to Bluetooth devices like phones, pads and laptops for music playback and hands-free calls.
- · Paired devices must support Bluetooth A2DP.



Product Description




(Power Button	Power On: Press to turn on; Warm light will remain on. Power Off: Press to turn off; All functions will be turned off.
Night Light Button	Press to turn on the warm light, press again to dim it, and press once more to turn it off. Press and hold to turn on the white light, press again to dim it, and press once more to turn it off.
★ Bluetooth Button	In power-on mode, press the Bluetooth button, the speaker will announce "Bluetooth is turned on" and enter pairing mode. Open your phone's Bluetooth settings to find and connect to "FS302." Once connected, the speaker will announce "Bluetooth Paired," allowing you to play music. When Bluetooth is turned off, it will announce "Bluetooth is disconnected."
Volume Up Button	Press to increase the volume.
Volume Down Button	Press to decrease the volume.

Product Operation

How to Connect Bluetooth and Use Music Playback

- 1. Turn on Bluetooth on your phone and search for Bluetooth devices.
- 2. In the list of discovered devices, click on "FS302." When you hear a successful pairing.
- 3. Once connected, you can choose your favorite music for playback. "Bluetooth Paired," it indicates




Salt Chunks Box Assembly/Disassembly Instructions

• Installation: Take the salt chunks box out of the packaging and align it with the top of the speaker, then place it


down.

• Disassembly: Just lift the salt chunks box off the top of the speaker.



Salt Chunks Usage Instructions


- 1. Take the salt chunks out of the white box and place them one by one into the box.
- 2. Add a few drops of concentrated essential oil to the salt chunks. (Rinse the salt chunks once a month and let them dry before reusing.)




Lanyard Installation Instructions

Pass the lanyard through the two holes on the side.

Thread the longer end through the loop of the shorter end, then gently pull to tighten the lanyard.
