BATTERY WARNING



This product uses three (3) LR44 / AG13, 1.5V Alkaline Button Cell Batteries.

- Remove and immediately recycle or dispose of used batteries according to local regulations. If no laws or regulations govern, dispose of your device in a waste bin for electronics.
- Keep batteries away from children. Do NOT dispose of batteries in household trash or incinerate. Even used batteries may cause severe injury or death. Call a local poison control center for treatment information. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.

- Always completely secure the battery compartment. If the battery compartment does not close securely, stop using the product, remove the batteries, and keep them away from children.

FAQ

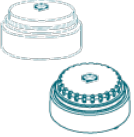
- **Q: Can I use rechargeable batteries with this product?**

A: No, non-rechargeable LR44 / AG13 batteries should be used. Do not attempt to recharge them.

• **Q: How do I know if my pet is ready to use the product?**

A: Supervise your pet during initial interactions. If your pet shows interest without trying to chew on the product, it may be ready for use.
