| () | Channel + | Pressing Channel Up increments the channel or moves the LED in the bar to the next. |
| (v) | Channel - | Pressing Channel Up decrements the channel or moves the LED in the bar to the previous. |
| (| Favorite | allows users to quickly access their preferred curtain positions with a single press.* |
| P | Prg | The Program button, accessible upon removing the back case, enables users to access programming functions |



Place or Change the battery


1. Press and slide the back cover from the remote control upward, exposing the battery compartment.



2. Insert the batteries, paying attention to match up the (+) and (-) ends of the batteries with the symbols inside the battery compartment.



3. Slide the battery cover back into place.



Select channel

- 1. Navigate with or or
- 2. LED indicates the channel number
- 3. Repeat the above, to activate again.

Child lock: locks all programming functions

- 1. Press P for 10 seconds
- 2. LED flickers 1x
- 3. Repeat the above, to activate again.

Set number of channels

- 1. Press for 3 seconds the
- 2. Set the number of active channels with the buttons
- 3. Press to approve
- 4. The

Note: if all LEDs are lit, that is channel 0 (all channels moving together)

Switch Protocol

Note: if you only have Forest motors without the Forest Link 2 protocol, you can switch from dual to single

protocol for legacy compatibility.

1. Remove the batteries

Troubleshooting

- 1. During use, when the remote control distance is significantly shorter or less sensitive, please check whether the battery needs to be replaced
- 2. When the battery voltage is insufficient, an orange LED will flicker upon pressing a button, signaling the need for battery replacement.


