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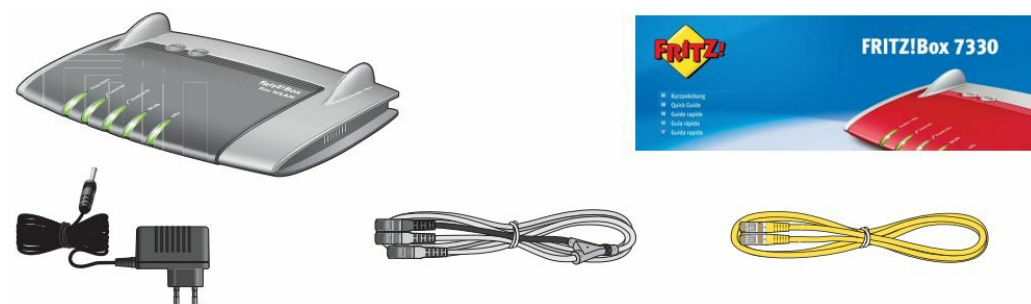

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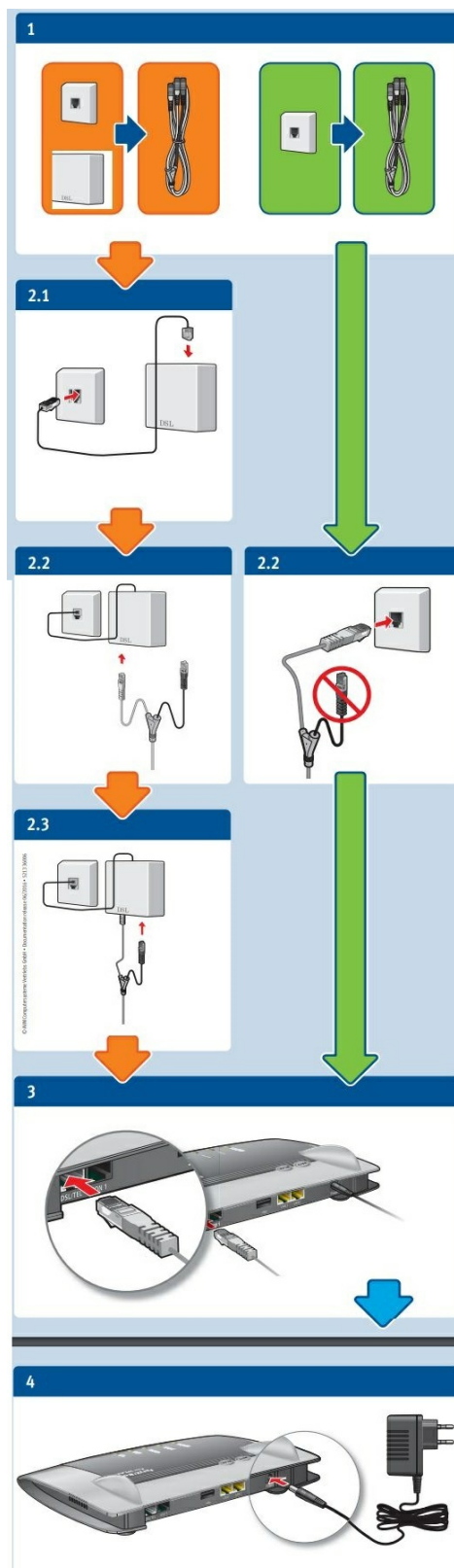


Safety Instructions

- Do not install the FRITZ!Box during an electrical storm.
- The ventilation slits of the FRITZ!Box must never be obstructed.
- Insert the FRITZ!Box into a power outlet located in the immediate vicinity.
- Do not place the FRITZ!Box on excessively heat-sensitive surfaces. The FRITZ!Box is intended for indoor operation only.

Note: See also the chapter on security and handling in your FRITZ!Box manual.

Wiring Connection



1. Set your connection type and follow the orange arrows if you have a landline and a DSL line, or the green arrows if you have a DSL line only.
2. Connect your telephone socket to your DSL splitter.
3. Connect the shorter end of the gray cable to the DSL line.
4. Connect the black end of the Y-shaped cable with the landline socket of your line.
5. Connect the gray, long end of the cable to the socket on the FRITZ!Box labeled "DSL/TEL".
6. Connect the FRITZ!Box to electrical power. The "Power/DSL" LED starts flashing.

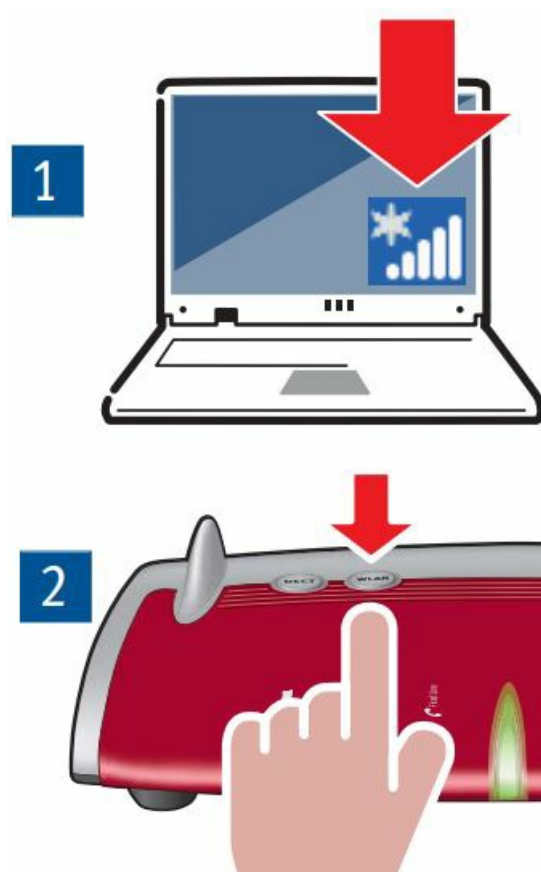
Telephones



Connect your telephone to the socket "FON 1".

- Put your DECT telephone in registration mode.
- Enter the PIN "0000" on the telephone.
- Press and hold down the "DECT" button on the FRITZ!Box.

WPS

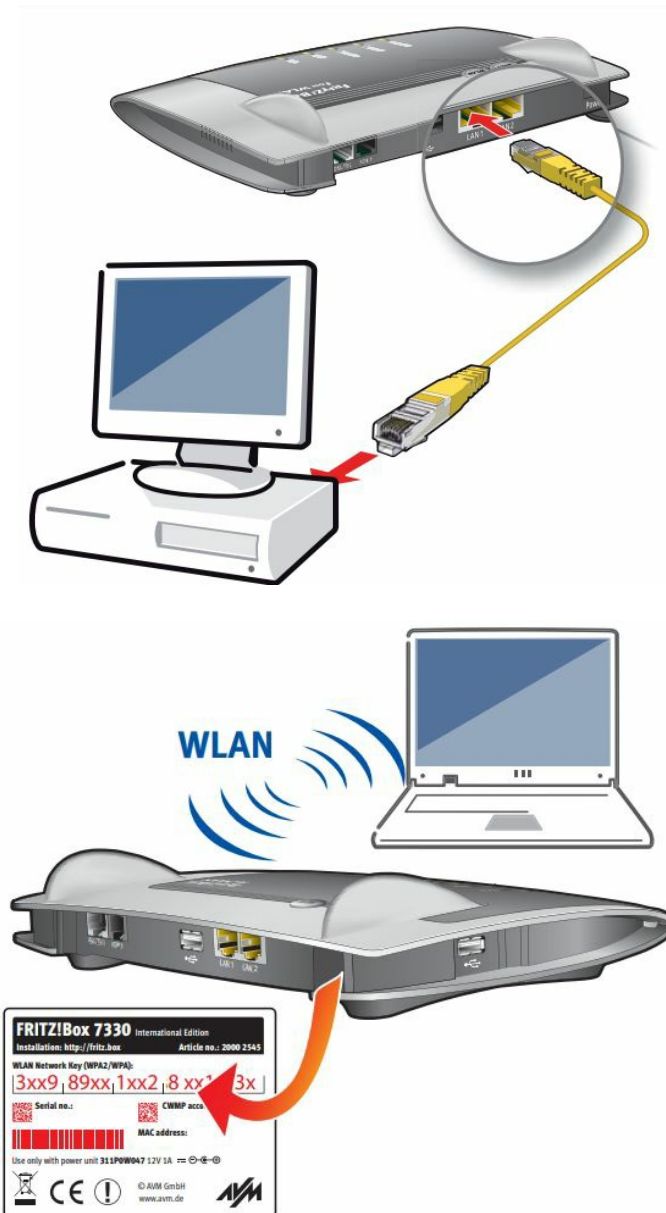


Computers with wireless LAN and the operating systems Windows 8.1 / 8 / 7 or Vista can be connected with the FRITZ!Box using the WPS quick connection.

- Click the WLAN icon in the notification area of the Windows taskbar.
- A list appears on the screen showing all wireless networks.
- Select the wireless network of your FRITZ!Box 7330 and click “Connect”.
- Press the “WPS” button on the FRITZ!Box 7330 until the “WLAN” LED begins flashing.

The wireless LAN connection will be established.

Connect Your Computer



Connect your computer using a LAN cable or establish a wireless LAN connection with the FRITZ!Box.

The FRITZ!Box has a user interface. This is where you configure all of the settings for operating. Just open a web browser and enter <http://fritz.box> in the address bar.

Internet

- Start a web browser.
- Enter the desired URL.

USB

The FRITZ!Box has two USB ports to which you can connect various USB devices. All computers in the network can use the USB devices that you connect to these ports.

LED

- **Power/DSL**
 - **flashing**: the connection is being established
 - **on**: FRITZ!Box is ready for operation
- **Internet**
 - **flashing**: you have new messages in your inbox
 - **on**: a telephone connection to the Internet is active
- **Fixed Line**
 - **flashing**: you have new messages in your inbox
 - **on**: a telephone connection over the fixed-line network is active
- **WLAN**
 - **flashing**: adopting the wireless LAN settings
 - **on**: wireless LAN settings are active
- **Info**
 - **flashing/on**: configurable
 - **red**: error
