




Multi-Product Mode (5050)



Turn Fryer ON



- 1. OFF appears in the status display when the controller is off.
- 2. Press the ON/OFF button.
- 3. LO- appears in a status display. If the melt cycle is enabled. MLT-CYCL will appear until the temperature is over 180°F (82°C).
- 4. Dashed lines appear in the status I display when the fryer is at setpoint basic operation

Launch Cook Cycle




- 1. Press a lane key.
- 2. PROD appears in the window above the pressed button. (An alarm sounds if a menu key is not pressed in five seconds.)
- 3. Press the menu key for the desired product
- 4. The display changes to the cooking time for the product and then alternates between the remaining cook time and the product name.

- 5. SHAK is displayed if a shake time was programmed.
- 6. Shake the basket and press the lane key to silence the alarm.
- 7. DONE appears at the end of the cook cycle.
- 8. Press the Lane key to eliminate the DONE display and silence the alarm.
- 9. Quality time is indicated by a flashing LED over the menu key. Press the key to display the remaining time.
- 10. LED flashes faster and an alarm sounds at the end of the quality countdown. Press the menu key under the flashing LED to halt the alarm

NOTE: To halt a cook cycle, press and hold the lane key under the displayed item for about five seconds.



Overview French Fry Mode (5060)



Menu keys are inactive for cooking in French Fry mode.

Basic Operation




Turn Fryer ON

- 1. OFF appears in the status display when the controller is off.
- 2. Press the ON/OFF button.

- 3. L0- appears in a status display. If the melt cycle is enabled, MLT-CYCL will appear until the temperature is over 180°F (82°C).
- 4. Dashed lines appear in the status display when the fryer is at the setpoint.

Launch Cook Cycle



- 1. FRY appears in all lanes.
- 2. Press a lane key.
- 3. The display changes to the cooking time for the fries, alternating with FRY
- 4. SHAK is displayed if a shake time was programmed.
- 5. Shake the basket and press the lane key to silence the alarm.
- 6. DONE appears at the end of the cook cycle.
- 7. Press the Lane key to eliminate the DONE display.
- 8. Display alternates between FRY and quality countdown.

NOTE: To halt a cook cycle, press and hold the lane key under the displayed item for about five seconds.

Programming New Menu Items in Multi-Product Computer

Follow these steps to enter a new product in the computer. The actions to be taken are in the right column; the computer displays are shown in the left and middle columns.

CODE		Enter 1650 with numbered keys. Press lane key B (Blue) to advance the cursor, and Y (yellow) key to go back. (NOTE: Press ü if the controller is in any language except English, o r the left display will be blank.)

TEND CC	1 YES	Press the key to advance to the desired position.
Product to be changed or open position	Number and Yes	Press ✓.
Product name with the cursor flashing under t he first character.	Edit	Enter the first letter of a new product with a numbered key. Press until the desired letter appears. Advance cursor left k ey. Repeat until the eight-letter or less name of the product i s entered. Eliminate characters with the key.
New product name	Edit	Press ✓.
Position number or ver sion of the previous na me.	Edit	Enter a four-letter abbreviated name, which will alternate wit h the cook time display during cook cycles.

SHAKE 1	M:00	Press to toggle between M (manually cancelling alarm) and A (automatically cancelling alarm). Enter time in the co ok cycle to shake the basket with the numbered keys.
SHAKE 1	Your settings	Press ✓
SHAKE 2	M:00	Press to toggle between M and A. Enter the time in the c ook cycle to shake the basket a second time.
SHAKE 2	Your settings	Press ✓
REMOVE	M:00	Enter cook time in minutes and seconds with numbered key s. Press to toggle between auto and manually cancelling alarm.
REMOVE	Your settings	Press ✓
QUAL	M: 00	Enter time product can be held after cooking. Press to to ggle between auto and manually cancelling alarm.
QUAL	Your Settings	Press. ✓
SENS	0	Sens allows the fryer controller to adjust cooking times sligh tly, ensuring small and large loads cook identically. Setting t he number to 0 allows no time adjustment; a setting of 9 pr oduces the most time adjustment. Enter the setting with a n umbered key.

New Product		If a key assignment is needed: press a menu key. Note: T his eliminates any previous link associated with the chosen key. Key not needed: skip to the next step

Changing Menu Items in Dedicated Computer

Follow these steps to change a product in the computer. The actions to be taken care in the right column; the computer displays are shown in the left and middle columns.

CODE		Enter 1650 with numbered keys. Press lanthe e key B (Blue) to advance the cursor, Y (yellow) key to go back.

Product name with curso r flashing under first char acter.	Edit	Enter the first letter of the product name with a number ed key. Press until the desired letter appears. Advance cursor left key. Repeat until the eight-letter or less nam e of the product is entered. Eliminate characters with the 0 key.

Previous abbreviated na me.	Edit	Enter a four-letter abbreviated name, which will alternat e with the cook time display during cook cycles.
Abbreviated name	Edit	Press .
Full name	YES	Press ✓.
SHAK 1	A:30	Press to toggle between M (manually cancelling alar m) and A (automatically cancelling alarm). Enter time in the cook cycle to shake the basket with the numbered keys.
SHAK 1	Your settings	Press ✓.
SHAK 2	A:00	Press to toggle between M and A. Enter the time in the cook cycle to shake the basket a
SHAK 2	Your settings	Press ✓.

REMOVE	M 2:35	Enter cook time in minutes and seconds with numbere d keys. Press to toggle between auto and manually cancelling alarm.
REMOVE	Your settings	Press .
QUAL	M 7:00	Enter time product can be held after cooking. Press á t o toggle between auto and manually cancelling alarm.
QUAL	Your Settings	Press ✓.
SENS	0	Sens allows the fryer controller to adjust cooking times slightly, ensuring small and large loads cook identically . Setting the number to 0 allows no time adjustment; a setting of 9 produces the most time adjustment. Enter setting with numbered keys.
SENS	Your setting	Press .

Computer Setup, Codes

Follow these steps to prepare the computer for placement on a fryer:

LeftDisplay	Right Display	Action
	OFF	Press 🗸
CODE		1656 with numbered keys.
GAS	YES or NO	Press to toggle between YES and NO. Leave at NO for electric fryer.
GAS	NO	With the desired answer in place press 🗸.
2 Basket	YES or NO	Press to toggle between YES and NO. Leave at NO for three baskets.
2 Basket	Y or NO	With the desired answer in place, press .
SET-TEMP	NONE 360	Enter cooking temperature for non-dedicated items with the numbered keys; 360°F is the default setting.
SET-TEMP	Entered temperature.	Press ✓.
SET-TEMP	DED 350	Enter cooking temperature for dedicated items with the numbered keys; 350°F is the default setting.
SET-TEMP	Entered temperature.	Press ✓.
	OFF	None. The setup is complete.
