1.4. Introduction

InnexScan is a robust scanning solution specifically engineered for the Innex DS200 document scanner. It enables rapid and efficient scanning of various document types, from business cards to books, converting them into high-quality image formats. The software offers multiple features, including document scanning, book digitization, barcode recognition, and video recording. With its integrated OCR (Optical Character Recognition) feature, scanned images can easily be converted into searchable PDF files or editable Word, Excel, ePub, and Text formats.

For book scanning, InnexScan delivers exceptional results with its advanced image processing features. It can automatically flatten curved book pages, digitally remove finger artifacts from scans, repair damaged or frayed document edges, align pages based on text orientation, and precisely split dual-page book scans into separate images.

NOTE: This software is distributed exclusively with the Innex DS200 document scanner. Full functionality, including advanced book scanning capabilities, is guaranteed only when paired with this hardware. When used with non-approved book scanners, certain features may be limited or unavailable.

Function Tabs

The InnexScan software offers various scanning modes that you can choose from. To select a mode, simply click the function tab.



Mode	Description
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Documen t	The Document mode is designed for scanning documents, business card s, ID cards, and other paper materials. This function features a powerful i mage processing algorithm that can repair damaged document edges and rotate pages based on text orientation. It allows you to scan directly into image formats like JPG, PNG, BMP, and TIFF, and also supports OCR for converting scanned files into editable PDF, Word, Text, or Excel formats.
Book	The Book mode is used to scan books or magazines. This function embe dded a Book Mode is designed for scanning books or magazines. This function features powerful image processing capabilities, including automatic scanning, flattening curved pages, removing fingerprints, cleaning up backgrounds, and splitting pages.
Barcode	The Barcode mode is used for scanning and recognizing barcodes or QR codes, then saving the results in JPEG, Text, Excel, or PDF formats.
ID Docum ent	Scan the ID card and recognize the MRZ code. Run OCR to recognize the text and save the result in a searchable PDF or Excel file format.
Video	The Video function allows you to record video tutorials in MP4 or MOV file formats

NOTE:

- Each of these Function Modes has different feature options and settings.
- Each of these Function Modes has its own file-saving directory. (For example,
 Document Mode can scan images into different file directories.)


4.1. Menu Options

4.3. Sub-Camera Settings:


In the Image Sub-Camera settings tab, you can select a position to merge the subcamera image from a secondary camera or webcam.

NOTE:

• Sub-camera function is available only in the ID Documents mode when the Scan mode is set to 'Multiple Page' and Video mode. You can choose to merge a portrait with the scanned image of an ID document or passport and export it. If you select Merge, you can set the portrait's position (webcam icon) relative to the scanned document (main camera). The merge is processed after clicking the Scan button. You can review the result in the preview thumbnails before exporting








Toolbar

On the left side toolbar, there are some useful control tools available:

Device Settings

At the bottom of the main window, there are some control settings for the camera device:

Video Settings	These video settings allow you to adjust the Brightness, Contra st, Hue, Saturation, Sharpness, and White Balance of Innex DS 200 Brightness Contrast Contr		
Resolution	Select the resolution of Innex DS200.		

NOTE:

 In the [Resolution] options, selecting a higher resolution will result in a lower video frame rate. If you are capturing a still image or scanning a document, select the highest available resolution. However, if you are using this device as a visual presenter, selecting a lower resolution may provide smoother video experience.

File Save Path Settings

On the right-hand side of the main window, there are options for setting the directory for saving files:



No.	Button	Explanations
1	Select	Select file save destination
2	Open	Open the current file location

NOTE:

All Function Modes share the same default file-saving directory. However, you can set a different save path for each mode.

File Output List

Right-click on the image file in the file fetching column on the right-side output list of the main window to access the following options:



Right Click Options	Explanations
Open	Open an image file
Delete	Delete a file
Properties	Show file information

NOTE:

• Use the Shift on the keyboard to select multiple image files.

Preview Thumbnails

In the left-hand preview window, you can use the tools available on each thumbnail to rotate scanned images, change their order, or delete them. You can also double-click a thumbnail to enter Document Page Editor mode.

↑	Move image up

NOTE:

The left side preview window is only available when the Scan Mode setting is set to [Multiple Image] mode.

1. Click the System Settings icon in macOS.




2. Go to Language & Region settings.




3. If you want to change only the InnexScan UI language, scroll down to "Applications", click "+", select "InnexScan", and choose your preferred language from the list.
