2. If the LED indicator flashes when pressing a key on the transmitter, it indicates low battery voltage. Please replace the battery with a new one.
3. If the transmitter will not be used for an extended period, please remove the battery.



1. **LED** Indicator
2. **Fan ON/OFF** (Pairing Button)
3. **Fan Speed Up**
4. **Fan Speed Down**
5. **Timer** Control
6. **Natural Wind**
7. **BATTERY:** 12V/23Ax 1
8. **Fan Forward/Reverse**

Use precautions

1. When press the key of transmitter, the LED indicator doesn't on, please inspect the battery installation.
2. When press the key of transmitter, the LED indicator flashing, that means the battery get low voltage, please replace a new one.
3. Please pull out of the battery from the transmitter when leaving unused for a long time.


