Place the Smart Sensor in the desired location to monitor relevant data and receive notifications on your device.

Maintenance:

Refer to the manual for maintenance tips and how to ensure proper functioning of the Smart Sensor.

Intended use:

The GARDENA smart Sensor is intended to control the smart system taking into account soil moisture and temperature in private domestic gardens, allotments and greenhouses. The GARDENA smart Sensor can only be used together with the GARDENA smart Gateway.

SAFETY

IMPORTANT!

- Read the operator's manual carefully before use.
- Ensure that the product is only used within the stated temperature range 1 °C to +50 °C.
- Do not use damaged products. Ensure that all parts are correctly disposed of with immediate effect.

- There is a risk of tripping. Position the sensor in such a manner that it can be seen at all times.
