Product Usage Instructions

- Before installing, consult the installation instructions provided with the product for the most up-to-date dimensional data.

Cabinet Installation

- Ensure a solid floor or suitable bracing to support the oven.
- Follow the specific cutout dimensions provided based on the model type.
- Construct a solid bottom using a minimum of 3/8 plywood supported by 2 x 4 or equivalent runners.
- Maintain the required clearances around the cutout on the front surface of the cabinet as specified.

Safety Precautions

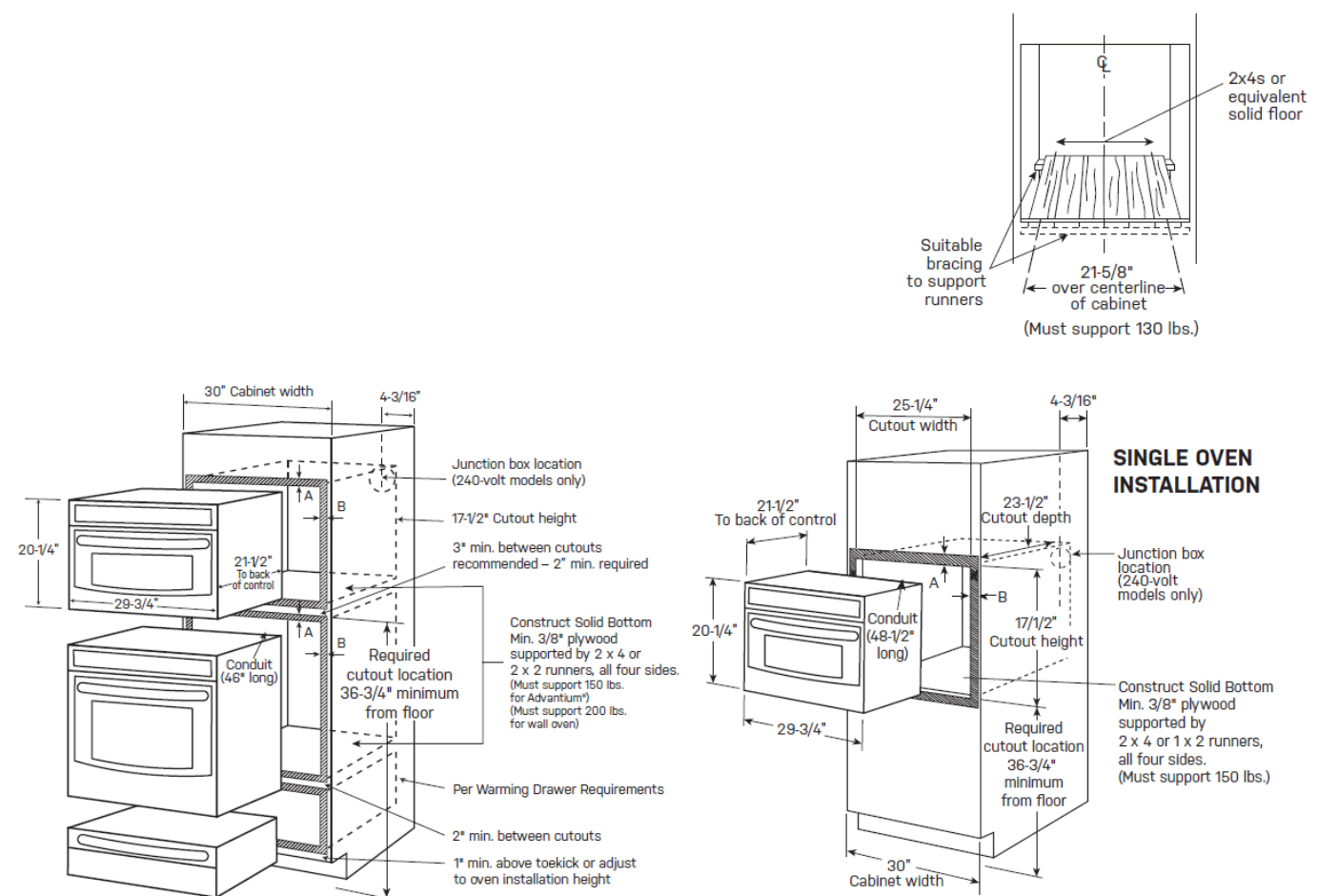
- Ensure proper electrical connections are made following local electrical codes.
- Do not operate the oven if damaged or if there are visible signs of wear.
- Refer to the user manual for specific operating instructions and maintenance guidelines.

FAQ

- **Q:** What is the weight capacity of the oven?
- **A:** The oven must be supported by a structure capable of holding 130 lbs. to 150 lbs. depending on the model.
- **Q:** Are there specific electrical requirements for installation?
- **A:** Yes, ensure proper electrical connections following local electrical codes, especially for 240-volt models.
- **Q:** What are the clearances required for cabinet installation?
- **A:** Allow clearances of 1-7/8 inches from the top, 2-3/8 inches from the side edges, and 1-1/8 inches from the bottom around the cutout on the front surface of the cabinet.

NOTE

- Cabinets installed adjacent to wall ovens must have an adhesion spec of at least a 194°F temperature rating.
- 2" minimum between cutouts when installed above warming drawer or single wall oven.
- Built-In Convection Oven can be installed in combination with other Built-In appliances. Always follow each product's Installation Instructions to complete the installation

INSTALLATION INFORMATION

Before installing, consult installation instructions packed with product for current dimensional data.

- A / B = Allow the following clearances around the cutout on the front surface of the cabinet: 1-7/8" from the top, 2-3/8" from the side edges, and 1-1/8" from the bottom.

NOTE: these refer to minimum clearances required for installation and do not reflect actual product dimensions.
