- **Type:** Portable Foldable Bluetooth Keyboard
- **Charging Port:** Type C
- **Charging Time:** Approximately 2 hours
- **Bluetooth Version:** 5.1

Product Usage Instructions

Charging the Foldable Bluetooth Keyboard

Before initial use, ensure the keyboard is fully charged.

Follow these steps:

1. Connect the Type C charging cable to the keyboard and the wall charger or computer USB port.
2. The charging indicator will be red while charging and will turn off once fully charged.
3. To prolong battery life, turn off the Bluetooth function when not in use.

Pairing and Connecting via Bluetooth

1. Turn on the Bluetooth Keyboard and tablet's Bluetooth function.
2. Press and hold the Bluetooth Connection Button on the keyboard until the indicator flashes.
3. Search for the device on your tablet and select the keyboard from the list.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the pairing process.

To clean the keyboard:

- Use water, alcohol, or an alcohol-based disinfectant.

Safety Precautions

- Avoid sharp objects, heavy items, heat, fire, and chemical liquids near the keyboard.

FAQ

Q: How long does it take to fully charge the keyboard?

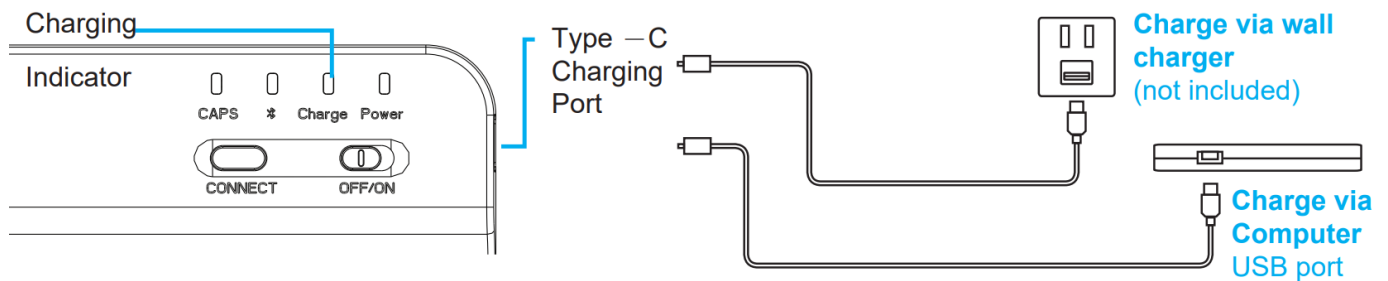
A: It takes approximately 2 hours to charge an empty battery.

Q: How can I extend my battery life?

A: Turn off the Bluetooth function when not in use and avoid using it in locations where Bluetooth needs to be turned off.

Portable Foldable Bluetooth Keyboard

Note: Please fully charge the Foldable Bluetooth Tablet Keyboard before use. It takes approximately 2 hours to charge an empty battery. Make sure your Wireless Tablet Keyboard is turned OFF.



CHARGING VIA WALL CHARGER

- Connect one end of the cable to the Type-C port and the other end to the wall charger.

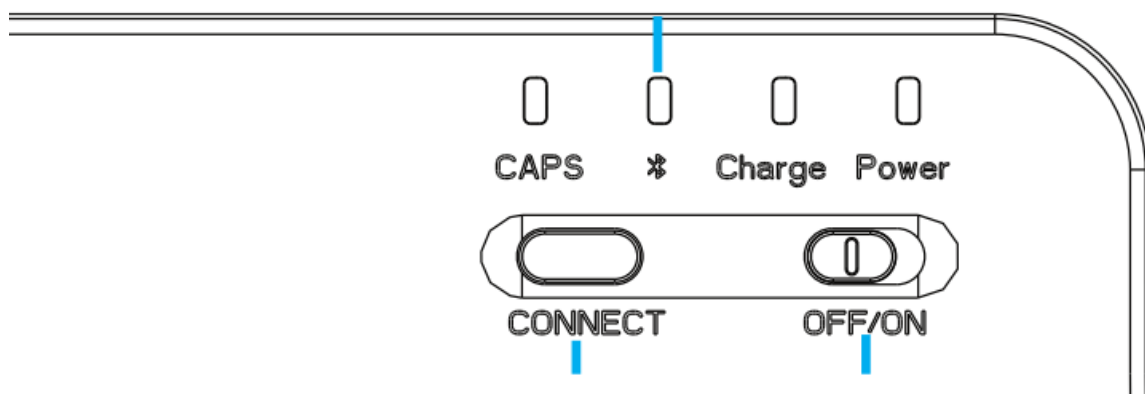
CHARGING VIA COMPUTER:

- Connect one end of the cable to the Type—C port and the other end to the computer's USB port
- While the Bluetooth Keyboard is charging, the charging indicator will be red. Once fully charged, the charging indicator will turn off.
- **Tip:** To extend the life of your battery between charges, turn off the Bluetooth function whether you are using it or not.
- You may also need to turn off the Bluetooth function in some locations. The bluetooth function will turn off when you switch to Airplane mode.

Power Button

- Follow the instructions to “pair” your devices for initial use. Once you have paired your tablet (device), you do not need to repeat the pairing process, the keyboard will automatically connect to the tablet (device) when both devices are switched on.
 - If using your Bluetooth keyboard with another device, you must repeat the pairing process.
1. Turn on your Bluetooth Keyboard by switching the power button from OFF to ON.
 2. Turn on your tablet’s Bluetooth function by going to Settings>Bluetooth & Networks. Slide the Bluetooth slider from OFF to ON.
 3. On the Bluetooth Keyboard, press and hold on the Bluetooth Connection Button for 3 seconds. then release it. The blue LED light (Bluetooth Connection Indicator) will start flashing while attempting to connect to the tablet.

4. On the tablet, click on the “Search for device” “Scan” button, and the tablet will take a moment to search for the Bluetooth Keyboard
5. Once the scan result list shows up click on the name of the device (see Figure A)

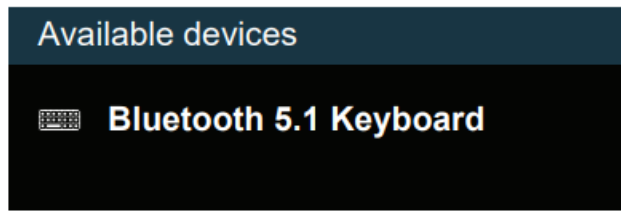

6. Once connected, a dialog window will pop up (see Figure B), please follow the instructions and type the requested number on your Bluetooth keyboard to complete the pairing process.

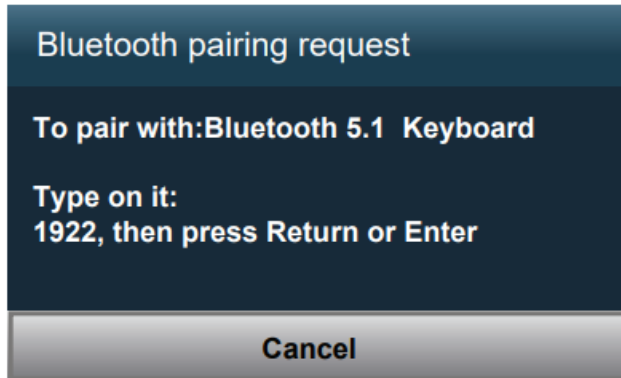

7. Connected to input device” will display on your tablet (see Figure C) when the devices have successfully paired. Now you may use your Bluetooth Keyboard.

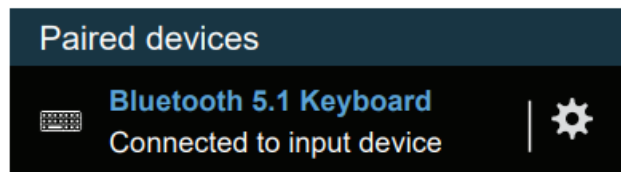

TO CLEAN:

Clean the keyboard with water, alcohol, or an alcohol-based disinfectant.

CAUTION:

- Keep away from sharp objects.
- Do not put heavy objects on the keyboard
- Keep away from heat and fire.
- Keep away from any chemical liquids
