Product Usage Instructions

Setting up GigaSpire BLAST:

- 1. Connect GigaSpire BLAST to a power outlet.
- 2. Use the supplied Ethernet cable to connect one end to a LAN port on your Internet access device (modem or ONT) provided by your service provider.
- 3. Connect the other end of the Ethernet cable to the WAN port on the back of the GigaSpire BLAST.
- 4. Wait for the device to boot up, which takes about 4 minutes.
- 5. A solid green light indicates a successful internet connection.

Setting up Wi-Fi:

Refer to the Quick Start Guide or App provided with GigaSpire BLAST to set up your Wi-Fi network.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- Q: What should I do if I do not see a solid green light after setting up the GigaSpire BLAST?

 A: If the indicator light does not turn solid green, check your cable connections and ensure proper setup following the provided instructions. If issues persist, contact customer support for further assistance.
- Q: Can I use a different Ethernet cable instead of the supplied one for setup?
 A: Yes, you can use a different Ethernet cable as long as it is compatible with the LAN and WAN ports on the devices being connected.


Quick Start Guide:

Setting up your GigaSpire BLAST

- 1. Connect GigaSpire BLAST to power outlet.
- 2. Connect one end of the supplied Ethernet cable to one of the LAN ports found on the back of the Internet access device provided by your service provider (e.g., modem or ONT) and the other end of the cable to the WAN port on the back of the GigaSpire BLAST.



- 3. The solid green light indicates SUCCESS! You are connected to the Internet.
- 4. Refer to the Quick Start Guide for the App to set up your Wi-Fi.
