Send them a personalized email after your Easter services.

Expressing your gratitude for their presence at your services is a great start to fostering a genuine relationship. You can also send them regular updates about upcoming events, sermon series, and volunteer opportunities to keep them engaged and informed about what's happening in your faith community. Stay connected with attendees on social media.

Posting recaps and updates about your services and activities can help increase familiarity and engagement with your organization. You can use these [templates](#) to share how your followers can continue supporting your congregation anytime, anywhere.



Encourage them to stay in the spirit of faithful generosity.

Research from Indiana University's Lake Institute on Faith & Giving revealed that places of worship that taught giving monthly saw a 73% increase in monetary gifts. That figure grew to 90% for places of worship that taught giving on a weekly basis.
