# Parent GO 4 Schools Mobile App Quick Start Guide

The GO 4 Schools Mobile App keeps you informed about any of your children who attend any school that subscribes to GO 4 Schools to ensure you can see how they are performing at school. The App is completely free of charge to both parents and students, where the school has a subscription to the GO 4 Schools App module and

# What the App can show you:

Currently you can view the timetable, homework, attendance, behaviour and attainment information for your children. This includes looking in depth at the homework set, including attached documents. You will also receive

notifications containing a summary of homework tasks and behaviour events at the end of the school day, and detentions as they are set/changed/cancelled.

- 1. Tap on the App to op en.
- 2. Type in your email ad dress and password.

  This is the same email a ddress and password yo u use to log into the GO 4 Schools website.
- 3. Click on 'log in'. If you are a first-time use r, you will need to log int o the website first to receive your password.



The homepage shows a student's current timetab le and overview of the st atus of their homework. Scroll down to see atten dance, behaviour and att ainment information. Tap on the timetable or h omework to view more in formation.



# Homework overview: ⊤

he homework card allow s you to filter by ongoing, extended, pend ing homework or history. You will also see which h omeworks your child has marked as 'Done'.

Tap on the specific home work you wish to view.



Homework detail: Detailed homework information is visible with attachments and weblinks.

If the school tracks home work you can see when a class teacher has ticke d off the completion of h omework tasks or marks if the work has been ass essed.

You will also see if your child has marked it as 'D one'.




## Messages

Tap on the menu in the t op-left corner to access messages and settings.



Messages from your sch ool and your settings can be accessed from this m enu.



In the **message inbox** t ap on the message for m ore detail.

Your messages will be o rganised by date order a nd titled by areas such a s Homework, Behaviour and Detention notifications.



Sample message: Here is an example of how a message might look. Tap back on messages a nd then your child's nam e to return to the main sc reen.



## Timetable:

From the main screen you c an also tap on the timetable for more information.



#### Timetable detail:

You are then presented with today's timetable. Youcan tap or swipe to previous and future days at the top.



## Attendance:

From the main screenscroll down to view attendance information. A chart displays the overall percentage



The App will also display detail a bout specific attendance marks i ncluding authorised and unauthorised attendance marks. Late marks are incorporated into the overall attendance marks and unknown marks are waiting for

#### Behaviour:

Continue to scroll down the app to the

Behaviour information.

This will display a bar chart of both negative and positive behaviour points over time, the chart can be scrolled across throughout the year. Positive points are shown in green and negative points in red with a total points count.



If you prefer you can toggle the graph to

show the number of events rathe r than

points. This will allow you to see the number of positive and negative events recorded over time. Again, you can scroll the chart a cross and positive events are in green and negative events in red.



#### Behaviour detail:

If you tap the 'details' button or tap in the

white space around the beh aviour chart

you can then view the detail ed event record

for your child including the d ate.


the subject, the event type and the associated points. This is useful to see if positi ve or negative behaviour are occurring in c

ertain lessons.



#### Attainment:

Scrolling down further, you can s ee the attainment card, showing how your child is doing in their s ubjects. The attainment card at t he top level provides their grade s, and their residual (how well they are doing when compared t o their target), if shared by their s chool.



Subject detail:
If you tap on a specific subject you can see an overview of attainment, behaviour and homework for that subject



You can easily return to the main screen by using the '< back' button.

Additional features may become available in the future depending on the different GO 4 Schools modules your school has selected.
