Important Safety Instructions


- This product is professional photographic equipment, to be operated by professional personnel only.
- All transport protective materials and packaging on the product must be removed before use.
- The following basic safety precautions must be followed when using this product.
 - Carefully read and fully understand the instruction manual before use and strictly follow the safety instructions. Failure to do so may result in death, serious injury, damage to the product, or other property damage.
 - 2. This product is a professional lighting fixture, children are prohibited from using it. Children must be closely supervised by adults when approaching the fixture, to prevent collisions with the fixture or unauthorized use that could cause personal injury.
 - 3. This is not an ordinary lighting fixture and must not be used for general illumination. Anyone with a history of eye damage or sensitivity should avoid using this fixture or looking directly at it.
 - 4. Extreme caution must be exercised when using it, do not touch hightemperature parts such as flash tubes to avoid burns.
 - 5. Do not point the flash directly at the eyes (especially the baby's eyes) under any circumstances, as this could impair vision in a short time. Turn off immediately if discomfort occurs, stop using, and seek medical attention promptly.
 - 6. If the flash tube is damaged, stop using it immediately and contact the manufacturer, service agent, or qualified repair personnel for a replacement to prevent accidents.
 - 7. Do not use damaged equipment or accessories. Allow professional repair technicians to inspect and confirm normal operation before continuing use after repairs.
 - 8. Turn off power before connecting or disconnecting plugs from outlets. Ensure plugs are fully inserted when connecting.
 - 9. Stop using immediately if the product shell is cracked due to falling, squeezing, or strong impact, to avoid touching the internal electronic components and getting an electric shock.
 - 10. This device is not waterproof. Keep it dry and avoid immersing it in water or other liquids. It should be installed in a ventilated and dry location and avoid use in rainy, humid, dusty, or overheated environments. Do not place items above the device or allow liquids to flow into it to prevent danger.
 - 11. Do not disassemble without authorization. If the product malfunctions, it must be inspected and repaired by our company or authorized repair personnel.

- 12. Before storing the device, ensure it has completely cooled down and the power cord is unplugged, then put it in the protective case or a ventilated dry location.
- 13. Do not place the device near alcohol. gasoline, or other flammable volatile solvents or gases such as methane and ethane.
- 14. Do not use or store this device in potentially explosive environments.
- 15. Do not use accessories not approved by our company, as this may cause fire, electric shock, or personal injury.
- 16. Clean gently with a dry cloth. Do not use a wet cloth as it may damage the device.
- 17. This product is powered by lithium batteries, which have limited lifespans and will gradually lose their charging capacities, which is irreversible.
 - As the battery ages, the product's battery life will decrease. The lifespan of a lithium battery is estimated to be 2 to 3 years.
- 18. This instruction manual is based on rigorous testing. Changes in design and specifications are subject to change without notice. Check the official website for the latest instruction manual and product updates.
- 19. Confirm and comply with all relevant local laws and regulations when handling any batteries.
- 20. The warranty period for this device as a whole is one year. Consumables (such as batteries), adapters, power cords, and other accessories are not covered by the warranty.
- 21. Unauthorized repairs will void the warranty and will incur charges.
- 22. Failures from improper operation are not covered under warranty.



What's Inside



Power Switch/Test Button

- Power On: Press and hold the button until the indicators turn on, and the flash is switched on.
- **Test:** After powering on, the green light blinks to indicate that the flash is recycling, which cannot be tested.

 After a few seconds, the green light is constantly on to indicate recycle done, then press the button once to fire

- a testing flash.
- Power Off: Press and hold the button until the indicators turn off, and the flash is switched off.

Power - Button/Power+ Button

- Press the power- button or power+ button can adjust the flash power in 5 levels. Press the power- button and power+ button at the same time can check the battery level.
- One grid of green light means one grid of battery level, a full battery level is five grids, so please charge the
 device in time if it only has one grid of battery level.

No Power Prompt

 When the five grids of indicator flash green at the same time, it means that the device is in a state of no power, unable to flash and recycle, and will automatically shut down after 30 seconds.

Auto Power Off

The flash will shut down automatically after I hour of idle use.
