

## **FRONT PANEL OVERVIEW**




- 1. IR



#### **QUICK START**

#### **TURNING ON AND OFF THE CD-5**

- Connect the CD-5 to the power using the supplied power cord.
- The status LED turns red to indicate the CD-player is on standby.
- With the remote: press the power button once (don't hold it down) to switch ON/OFF the CD-5.
- With the touchscreen: tap the display on the left part and hold for 3 seconds to turn ON/OFF the unit.



Tap and hold for 3 seconds

#### **USING THE CD-5**


Thanks to the touchscreen display all the functions of the CD-5 can be adjusted on the go. The display shows the track number, the time progression and the play mode.

#### LOADING AND UNLOADING DISCS

- Tap the EJECT button on the display or on the remote to open the tray.
- Insert the disc and close the tray by pressing again the EJECT button or tapping on the display.
- The CD-5 will load the disc before displaying the playback controls.
- The disc can be ejected at anytime only after the playback has stopped.

#### **PLAYBACK CONTROLS**

- Press PLAY once to start the playback.
- Press SKIP / to advance or skip the track forwards and backward.
- Press PAUSE **II** to pause the playback.
- Press STOP to cancel the playback.
- Press and hold SKIP to move forward/backward on the track a slow speed. Hold SKIP for more than 3 seconds to move forward/backward on the track at high speed.



#### **CD MENU**

Swipe the finger left/right to enter the menu and browse the settings, then tap once to adjust the selected setting. To exit the menu, swipe until BACK  $\stackrel{\frown}{\longrightarrow}$  is selected, then tap once.

#### **PLAY MODE**

The CD-5 supports several playback modes

## . Normal play

Plays once all the tracks in incremental order.

## . X Shuffle

Plays once all the tracks on the disc in random order.

## Shuffle repeat

Plays all the tracks on the disc in random order. Starts again when finished.

## • Repeat all

Plays all the tracks in incremental order. Starts again from track 1 after playing the last track.

# Repeat track

Plays the selected track on repeat.

#### **DISPLAY BRIGHTNESS**

Swipe the finger left/right to choose the desired brightness, then tap it once to confirm.

The brightness can be set to:

- High
- Low
- OFF

When the display is set to OFF, tap the display or push a button on the remote to activate it again for 3 seconds.

#### **DEVICE INFORMATION**

The device information include:

- Model
- Serial number (S/N)
- Firmware version running on the CD-5
- Servo version (for service)



#### REMOTE CONTROL

#### **USING THE REMOTE CONTROL**

Select CD on the remote, then use the buttons for playback control to conveniently operate the CD-5 from your listening position.

To play a specific track, use the numbers on the key pad to select it, playback will start automatically.

#### **PLEASE NOTE**

To play a specific track ensure the CD-5 is set to Normal, Repeat All or Repeat Track. If the CD-5 is set to a different playback mode, selecting a track from the remote will force the CD-5 to automatically switch to Normal play mode.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

PROBLEM	CAUSE	SOLUTION
The remote doesn't work.	The GN remote can be used to control more than one unit. To control each unit the correct mode must be selected on the remote.	Press the "CD" button on the remote.
	The batteries are too low.	Replace the batteries in the remote.
The unit doesn't work.	The unit is not powered correctly.	Check that the power cord and the wall outlet are working.
	The unit has triggered the protection mode due to improper use or unstable power supply.	Turn OFF the unit, then unplug it from the AC socket and wait 60 seconds, then plug it back and turn the CD-5 ON.
	The fuse in the AC socket is blown.	Call a certified Gold Note dealer to schedule a service operation. Do not attempt to replace the blown fuse on your own.
The digital RCA output doesn't work.	The connection cable used is not a $75\Omega$ digital cable.	Use a $75\Omega$ digital cable.
	Your AC power system is not grounded.	Contact a certified dealer for assistance.

There are issues with the performance of the unit.	The unit is not properly levelled.	Make sure the unit is perfectly levelled with the help of a spirit level or a high precision level.
The CD is not recognised or can't be played by the unit.	The CD is not correctly inserted.	Make sure the CD is properly inserted and with the label/printed side facing up.
	The CD is too dirty or ruined to be read.	Check the CD for scratches and dirt, try to clean the CD using a soft dry cloth.
	The CD is stuck inside the tray.	Contact a certified Gold Note dealer to remove the CD and check the unit for damages.
	The CD format is not compatible.	The CD Player is designed under the RED BOOK standard technology. Always verify that the CDs are compatible with the unit.
The output signal is distorted.	Your amplifier is overloaded, resulting in overmodulation of the signal.	Try to use the RCA connection and contact the manufacturer of the amplifier to receive further information.
The audio signal is unstable and/or the audio output is not balanced.	Some components are not working correctly and might have been damaged.	Contact a certified Gold Note dealer for assistance.

## **CLEANING THE UNIT**

With EXTREME care use ONLY water or detergents for delicate surfaces with a very soft cloth to sweep dust and remove stains.

Any acid or not extremely soft cloth will irreversibly damage the unit. Do not use alcohol.
