Compatibility

Compatible with iPadOS 13 (with newer versions). We recommend that you upgrade your ipad to 13.4.1 for best performance.

To check your iPad system version.

- 1. Settings Seneral > About > Software Version.
- 2. Upgrade to iPadOS 13.4.1 or later to properly use the touchpad feature.



Upgrade your ipad to the latest version:

Open your device's Settings Seneral > Software Update




2. Click "Download and Install".


*If you see Resume Download, click it.

Settings

Pairing with the tablet.


1. Switch the ON/OFF to the ON position





3. Switch "Bluetooth on" in "Settings"







- 4. Click "Settings" "Bluetooth" "Available devices" Bluetooth Keyboard"
- 5. Click Pairing in the pop-up window. (When the Bluetooth indicator stops flashing, the device is connected)

When pairing with a new device, repeat steps 1-5 after the connect indicator appears, and pairing is complete.

Note: Keyboard supports simultaneous connection of two devices, short press FN + C / V switch Bluetooth BT1 / BT2




If your system is 13.3.1, please follow the steps below to enable the touchpad function:


- 1. Go to Settings > Accessibility > Touch
- 2. Make sure the Assistive Touch option is turned on



Shortcut Keys

Tip: When the red light flashes, please note that the device needs to be charged and the working voltage only supports 5V.






Touchpad Functions

Note: Please make sure the device is connected and the keyboard touchpad function is turned on.

One-finger tap




Action 1: Tap once in the main interface

Function: Mouse cursor click
Action 2: Tap 2 times and swipe
Function: Select or move icons


Action 3: Tap twice when iPad is in sleep mode

Function: Wake up the tablet


Tap with two fingers



Action 4: Tap the trackpad once **Function:** Show quick actions.




Two-finger swipe



Action 5: Slide finger up/down

Function: Scroll up/down web pages or files Action 6: Slide your finger left and right Function: Flip the page to the left or right


Two-finger zoom



Action 7: Two fingers for zooming in or out

Function: Zoom in or out of a page (only available on websites or documents)


Three-finger swipe up



Action 8: Swipe up

Function: Open the app switcher

Three-finger swipe left to right



Action 9: Swipe left to right **Function:** App window switching

Move the cursor to the bottom of the screen

Function: Cut out the DOCK bar



Move the cursor to the top right comer

Function: Open the control center



In the application page


Touch and hold the left trackpad, you can drag the application icons to where you want them to be Touch and hold the right trackpad.

Show App menu (same as right mouse button.



On the Edit page

Touch and hold the left trackpad, you can select the text you want and you can drag and drop around the text.





Installation and Removal

- 1. Put one end of the tablet into the bottom of the case (p attention to the alignment of the camera hole)
- 2. Push the tablet into the case.




- 1. Press the two corners of the top of the case and push out.
- 2. Remove the tablet.



Charging

- 1. Turn on the keyboard. (if the power indicator flashes, please charge the keyboard)
- 2. Plug the charging cable (included) into the keyboard and charger
 - a) Keyboard charging light turns red.
 - b) When charging is complete, the battery indicator goes off.


Troubleshooting

If the keyboard does not work properly, please check the following things:

- 1. The Bluetooth function of the tablet (or other Bluetooth devices) is turned on;
- 2. Bluetooth keyboard is within 33 feet;
- 3. Bluetooth keyboard is charged;
- 4. Make sure the keyboard is powered on (battery indicator is on);
- 5. Make sure the keyboard has been paired via Bluetooth.

If you have unwanted autocorrect or punctuation, please follow these steps:

- 1. Open Settings>General>Keyboard>Hardware Keyboard;
- 2. Turn off Auto-Capitalization Auto-Correction and "." Shortcut (see the picture below).



If Bluetooth pairing fails, please try the following steps:

- 1. Press and hold the key, the red, green, and blue indicator lights are on at the same time, then release, the keyboard has been restored to factory settings.
- 2. Delete all Bluetooth devices on the tablet;
- 3. Turn off the Bluetooth function on the tablet;
- 4. Restart the tablet:
- 5. Turn on the Bluetooth on the tablet;
- 6. Switch the keyboard switch;
- 7. Repeat the "Setup" steps in the manual to pair the keyboard.
