Selecting the Gutter Style

When choosing a gutter style, consider the following\ options:

- K-Style: Common in residential markets.
- Half Round: Traditional style predating K-Style.
- Fascia: Eliminates the need for fascia boards, ideal for cost-effective design.

Selecting the Gutter Size

For selecting the right gutter size:

- K-Style & Half Round: Take measurements of Side A (backside) and Side B (top side).
- Fascia: Measure both sides and order custom-made GutterFoam based on your dimensions.

Selecting the GutterFoam Model

Choose from the following GutterFoam models based on your needs:

- GutterFoam EZ: Basic model for budget-conscious consumers.
- GutterFoam: Provides protection from leaves and debris.
- GutterFoam Pro: Fully coated for extra protection, suitable for densely populated areas.

• GutterFoam FR: Fire retardant coating, ideal for wildfire-prone regions.



SELECTING THE GUTTER STYLE

When it comes to figuring out what type of gutter is on your house, it is important to understand the different types of gutters that are out on the market. Predominately, there are three main categories for gutters: K-Style, Half Round, and Fascia

K-Style

• K-Style gutters are the most common style of gutters in the residential market.



Half Round


• Half Round gutters have been around for years, prior to the invention of the K-Style gutter, half round gutters were the most commonly used gutter-style



Fascia

• The Fascia gutter style comes from fascia boards, which are used to cap the ed of the rafters ouside a building.


Generally, K-Style and Half Round gutters have to be attached to fascia boards, however, Fascia gutters do not need to be. They eliminate the need for that fascia board, allowing for an inexpensive gutter design (typically used in California). Fascia gutters have a longer backside then the topside.



SELECTING THE GUTTER SIZE


When determining the size of your gutter, it is important to keep safety in mind. When getting up to your gutter, make sure that the ladder is secure and is tied off. Once by the gutters, it is necessary to take two measurements. These are shown below as side A and B.



Fascia


Fascia style gutters vary in size so drastically that there are no standard size gutters. Therefore, GutterFoam has developed an easy to use system for ordering custom made GutterFoam for Fascia gutters.



Simply measure Side A (the backside of the gutter) and Side B (the top side of the gutter). GutterFoam size to purchase is the one that matches both of your dimensions. If your size is not listed on our website, we can custom cut as Fascia sizes can widely vary.

SELECTING THE GUTTERFOAM MODEL

GutterFoam comes in six different models: GutterFoam EZ, GutterFoam, & GutterFoam Pro, GutterFoam FR, GutterFoam ProFR, GutterFoam ProFR Plus All six models are composed of the same durable polyether foam with the built in germicide and UV stabilizer. However, each of the models has a different warranty length an may have additional coating on the product for extra protection



GutterFoam



GutterFoam Ez is the basic model of the GutterFoam Family. GutterFoam Ez is made for the consumer that needs gutter protection, however, may not have a big budget for this addition





GutterFoam is the foam filter insert that was brought to the market in 1994. Surfaced coated to provide a layer of protection from the sun. GutterFoam is made for the consumber that gets a considerable amount of leaves and debris.





GutterFoam Pro is the professional GutterFoam product. Fully coated to provide extra protection from the sun. GutterFoam Pro is made for those who live in heavily dense areas





GutterFoam FR is the fire retardant GutterFoam product. An extra surface coating includes a fire retardant compount. GutterFoam FR is made for those who live in areas prone to wildfires





GutterFoam ProFR is fully coated for UV, germicide, and fire protection. GutterFoam ProFR is made for those who want the highest quality gutter protection system at an affordable price





GutterFoam ProFR is our newest and best model. It is Class A rated, which means that it will not start a fire when exposed to a flame. It meets the standards required by the California Building Code Section 7A. Testing is done per Section 703A and SFM Standard 12-7A-5, Ignition-Resistant Material, in accordance with ASTM E84-18 "Standard Method of Test for Surface Burning Characteristics of Building Materials". If you live in a California Wildlife Urban Interface (WUI) zone, GutterStuff Pro FR PLUS is the accepted gutter filter for these zones.
