



- 3. Button (a): Activation of hyperlinks -when the button is held: Size change Double-click: change of the function types, see "6. Function types".
- 4. Display: Timer display -Remaining presentation time

- 6. Timer button:activate and displaythe preset timer -when the button is held: Timer display Double-click: Start timer

Operation

5.1 Charge the Spotlight Presenter

If the following symbol appears on the display: " " "

the battery status is low. Connect the supplied USB charging cable to the USB-C port (5). Connect the free plug on the USB charging cable to asuitable USB charger.

A complete charging cycle takes about 2hours.




Marning -rechargeable battery

- Only use suitable charging devices or USB connections to charge the product.

5.2 Quick start

- 1. Plug the receiver into an available USB port on your device.
- 2. After automatic driver installation, the removable data medium opens



- 3. Install the required Spot-Pointer software
- 4. Switch the Presenter on following successful installation (7).

If the Presenter is switched off, or if the receiver is not connected to the computer, this will be indicated by acolour less symbol.

Function types

1. Spot illumination mode



2. Magnifying glass function




3. Digital laser pointer



- Pressing the obutton (3) twice allows you to toggle between the function types
- By pressing and holdingthe obutton (3), youcan change the size of the laser pointer, spot and magnifying glass with the two function keys (1) and(2)

Software functions



- 1. Selection to set the function type
- 2. Individual setting of the background shading when spot illumination modeisactive
- 3. Setting of the background transparency when spot illumination mode is active
- 4. Individual setting of the colour of the digital pointer
- 5. Setting of the transparency of the digital pointer
- 6. Setting of the size of the modes used
- 7. Setting of the magnifying glass's zoom function
- 8. Timer: Beforethe meeting, set atime for the vibrationalarm (maximum alarm time: 199 minutes). The display allows you to keep an eye on the presentation time.
