### **Explanation of warning symbols and notes**




This symbol is used to indicate safety instructions or to draw your attention to specific hazards and risks.

### **Package contents**



- a. 1 bike chain lock
- b. 1 LED illuminated key incl. 1 button cell CR1620
- c. 1 key

### Safety instructions

- Clean the illuminated key with a damp cloth. Do NOT immerse the illuminated key in water, and do not use any chemical cleaning or scouring agents.
- Keep the illuminated key away from objects with sharp points (e.g. toys, writing implements, etc.) so that the illumination function is not accidentally switched on, using up power.
- This product is intended for private, non-commercial use only.
- Use the product only for the intended purpose.
- Protect the product from dirt, moisture, and overheating, and use it in dry environments only.
- Do not use the product in the immediate vicinity of heaters, other heat sources, or in direct sunlight.
- Do not drop the product and do not expose it to any major shocks.
- Do not modify the product in any way. Doing so voids the warranty.
- Do not open the device or continue to operate it if it becomes damaged.
- Do not attempt to service or repair the product yourself. Leave any and all service work to qualified experts.
- As with all electrical products, this device should be kept out of the reach of children.
- Only use the article under moderate climatic conditions.
- Do not use the product in areas in which electronic products are not permitted.
- Dispose of packaging material immediately in accordance with the locally applicable regulations.

• Do not operate the product outside the power limits given in the specifications.



# Warning – Batteries

- When inserting batteries, note the correct polarity (+ and markings) and insert the batteries accordingly.
   Failure to do so could result in the batteries leaking or exploding.
- Only use batteries (or rechargeable batteries) that match the specified type.
- Before you insert the batteries, clean the battery contacts and the polarity contacts.
- Do not allow children to change batteries without supervision.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, or batteries of different types or from different manufacturers.
- Remove the batteries from products that are not being used for an extended period (unless these are being kept ready for an emergency).
- · Do not short-circuit batteries.
- · Do not charge batteries.
- · Do not burn batteries.
- Keep batteries out of the reach of children.
- Never open, damage, or swallow batteries or allow them to enter the environment. They can contain toxic, environmentally harmful heavy metals.

### Warning - Button cells

- This product contains button cells. If the button cell is swallowed, serious internal burns can occur within 2 hours and ultimately lead to death.
- · Keep new and used batteries out of the reach of children.
- If the battery compartment will no longer close securely, stop using the product and keep it away from children.
- If you suspect that batteries have been swallowed or are in any part of the body, seek medical attention immediately.

### Changing the battery

Replace the battery when the LED key's light begins to fade:

- pull the battery compartment out.
- Remove the spent battery and replace it with a new battery of type CR1620, observing the correct polarity as indicated in the battery compartment.
- · Slide the battery compartment back in.


