Bring the HandFan HF310 Rechargeable Handheld Fan with you to the office or at home to stay cool. This fan has a sleek, small form and moves a lot of air in a light, portable package. It cools consistently wherever you need it and can be powered by a recharging battery or an electric cord. The fan has three-speed levels that you can change to make the airflow just right for you. Its six blades move air around efficiently, and its quiet operation keeps the noise level at 50 dB. It is made of strong polyethylene and acrylonitrile butadiene styrene, so the HandFan HF310 will last for a long time. This fan is the right mix of ease of use and cooling power, whether you're working in the office or just relaxing at home. With extras like a power bank function for emergencies, it's a great deal at \$23.99 and a great value for the money.

FEATURES

• **Features**: It's not only a handheld fan, but it can also be used as a portable power bank to charge your devices. This makes it a useful outdoor tool.



- Long Battery Life: The fan has a 5200mAh recharging battery that lets it run for 20 hours at speed 1, 9 hours at speed 2, and 5 hours at speed 3.
- **Motor Without Brushes**: A DC motor without brushes guarantees great efficiency, long life, and continuous performance.
- Large Amount of Air: The fan has 6 blades, each one 3.5 inches long, which make it able to move a lot of air and cool things down well.
- Portable and Lightweight: It only weighs 0.49 pounds and is 8.6 x 3 x 1.2 inches, so it's very portable and easy to carry.



- **Multiple Speeds**: The fan has three speeds, so you can change the flow of air to suit your needs.
- Adjustable Wind Angle: The fan can be turned from 0° to 180° to get the most air flow and comfort for you.
- **USB Rechargeable**: A 5V USB rechargeable battery powers the fan and can be charged through a normal USB port.
- Effective Cooling: The big 6-blade fan and strong motor create a strong wind that cools the room well in hot weather.

SETUP GUIDE

• Unbox the Fan: Carefully take the fan out of its box and make sure all of its parts are still together.

- Power On: To turn on the fan, press the power button. The fan should start up right away.
- Change Speed: You can choose from 3 different speed levels by pressing the buttons.
- Fold the Fan: To fold the fan, slowly move it between 0° and 180° and make sure the fan head stays in place.
- Charge Your Device: To use the fan as a power bank, connect your device to the USB output port with the right charge cable.



- Tilt the Fan: To get the best airflow, tilt the fan gently between 0° and 180° to change its angle.
- Place on Desk: To cool off without using your hands, fold the fan into a 90° or 180° angle and set it on a desk or table.
- Check Battery Indicator: While the device is being used, check the indicator to make sure the battery is fully charged.
- **Use Outside**: If you want to use the fan outside, make sure it's fully charged and bring a charging cable with you in case you need to keep it running.
- Remove the Fan Blades: Every so often, use a soft cloth to remove the fan blades.
- How to Carry the Fan: To make it easier to carry when you're going, fold the fan up small and put it in your bag.
- Battery Charging: To make sure the fan works at its best, always charge the battery when it gets low.
- Flip It Off When Not In Use: To save power, flip the fan off when not in use.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Every so often: Wipe the fan blades and body clean with a soft cloth to get rid of dust and dirt.
- Avoid Water: To keep the fan from getting damaged, keep it away from water and damp places.
- Do Not Drop: Be careful when you handle the fan so that you don't hurt the motor or blades.
- Not overcharging: To keep the battery healthy, unplug the fan once it's fully charged.
- Store in a Dry Place: If you're not going to use the fan for a long time, keep it somewhere dry and cool to keep the batteries from getting damaged.
- Gentle Clean: To clean between the fan blades, use a cotton swab or compressed air.
- Make Sure Nothing Is in the Way: Make sure nothing is blocking the fan's air flow or motor.
- Handle Carefully: To keep the fan from breaking or getting damaged inside, don't drop it or handle it roughly.
- Keep an eye on the battery life: If the fan's battery isn't keeping a charge well, it might be time to get a new one.
- Use Only Approved Chargers: To keep the battery from getting damaged, only charge the fan with the USB charger that came with it or one that works with it.
- Stay Away from Heat: Don't leave the fan out in direct sunlight or near heat sources for long amounts of time.
- Battery Care: If you're going to store the battery for a long time, make sure it's charged to about 50%. This will keep the battery healthy.
- Checking the Fan Blades: Make sure to check the fan blades often for any signs of damage or wear.
- Avoid Using Too Much Force: To keep the fan from breaking, don't push it too far when folding or adjusting it.
- Recycling Batteries: When it's time to get a new battery, make sure you recycle the old one properly to protect the earth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan won't turn on	The battery is drained or improperly connected	Recharge the battery or check the con nection
Weak airflow	Fan blades are obstructed	Clean the fan blades and remove any debris
Fan is not charging	The charging cable is faulty	Try using a different charging cable or charger
Fan is making excessive noise	Fan blades may be misaligned	Check for misalignment and adjust the blades
Fan shuts off unexpectedly	Overheating or battery issues	Let the fan cool down and recharge full y
Fan only works at one speed	Speed settings malfunctioning	Reset the fan or try cycling through the speeds
Fan runs for a short time only	Battery capacity is too low	Recharge the battery and try again
The fan has a blinking charging indicator	Charging issue or faulty connection	Ensure the charger is properly connect ed
Fan operates but the LED light i s off	Power saving mode or battery issue	Turn on the LED display via the control button
Fan is not providing enough airfl ow	Insufficient battery power	Recharge the fan fully and test again
Fan turns on but doesn't produc e airflow	Motor issue or faulty blades	Check the motor and clean the fan bla des
USB cable connection is loose	Poor USB connection	Reconnect the USB cable securely
Battery life is too short	Battery aging or long usage time	Replace the battery if it's no longer hol ding charge
Fan is shaking or vibrating	Loose internal parts	Tighten the fan components or contact support
Fan is not responding to the tou ch control	Sensor or control issue	Reset the fan or check for sensor dam age

PROS & CONS

Pros:

- Compact and portable, easy to carry around.

- Three adjustable speed settings for personalized airflow.
- Quiet operation at just 50 dB, ideal for indoor use.

Cons:


• Limited to indoor use, not ideal for outdoor activities.

- Corded power may limit movement if not in battery mode.
- Only three-speed levels; some may prefer more options.
- Slightly higher noise than some other fans in this category.
- Blade length may not provide high airflow for larger rooms.
