Operating Instructions

- 1. **Power:** Push to turn the unit on/off. Green LED light indicates power on, red LED light indicates standby mode.
- Adjust UP/DOWN: UP button increases values on OSD menu and for color adjustment. DOWN button decreases values on OSD menu and for auto adjustment.
- 3. Item: Hot key for OSD adjustments of Volume, Contrast, Brightness, Red, Green, Blue.
- 4. Menu: Push to call out OSD menu or used as confirm function in OSD menu.

FAQ

Q: What do I do if liquid or solid objects fall into the cabinet?

A: Unplug the unit immediately and have it checked by qualified personnel before further operation.

Q: Can I use strong solvents for cleaning?

A: No, avoid using strong solvents like thinner or benzene as they may damage the unit's finish. Use a slightly damp cloth with a mild detergent instead.

Q: Is the unit waterproof?

A: No, the unit is not designed to be waterproof. Avoid exposure to rain or water to prevent damage.
