Double timer

Powered by: 2 X 1.5V AAA battery (not included)

Time settings: 0 – 99 hours 59 mins 59 secs

Operating instructions

- Open the stand and then slide to open the cover at the back. Insert the battery into the compartment with the +/- at the appropriate place as shown.
- Slide to close the cover at the back.
- After inserting the battery a short beep sounds and the screen displays 0:0000.
- The timer is ready for use now and has an add and countdown function.
- Magnet is fixed to the back of the timer allowing it to be attached to a metal surface.
- With a stand at the back to use on tabletop.
- With hole at the back for wall hanging.

Setting alarm mode

- Set your desired alarm modes at the side of the timer.
- High volume.
- Low volume.
- Silent and red light flashing.

Button

T1: Timer 1

T2: Timer 2

M: Memory button





HOUR: setting hour

MIN: setting minute



SEC: setting second

  : start or stop the timer

Count down

- Press **T1/T2** to choose timer
- Press **HOUR/MIN/SEC** buttons to your desired timing. Hold the buttons to increase the time quickly.
- If reset is necessary, press **HOUR** and **MIN** buttons at the same time.
- When target time is set, press   button to start count down. Press it again to stop counting. When timer is stopped, press **HOUR** and **MIN** at the same time to reset timer.
- When timer reaches to 0:0000, it will switch to count up immediately. Press   button to stop counting. Alarm or red light flashing will last for one minute when no operation.

Count up

- Press **T1/T2** to choose timer
 - Press   button to start count up.
 - Press   button to stop count up when necessary. Press **HOUR** and **MIN** at the same time to reset timer.
- Noted: In the first hour of count up, display can show 1/100 sec. For more than one hour, display will only show 2/100 sec.

Memory function

- Press **T1/T2** to choose timer. Hold **M** button for 3 seconds, display will flash. Press **HOUR/MIN/SEC** to your desired

timing. Hold the button to increase the time quickly.

- Press M to save the data.
- If necessary, press HOUR and MIN at the same time to clear memory.
- Once user sets the memory time, he can return to the memory time quickly by only pressing M button when timer is stopped.

Note: Two timers (T1/T2) can work at the same time without any influence to each other.

Replacing the battery

- If the digits are difficult to read, this is a sign that the battery is getting low. Then the battery must be replaced by opening the cover at the back.
- Always open the stand first and slide to open and close the battery compartment cover at the back.

Battery safety instructions

- DANGER OF EXPLOSION! Dry batteries must not be re-chargeable or throw in the fire or short-circuited.
- Do not expose batteries or appliance to extreme temperature such as from direct sunlight or fire. Do not place the product on a heating source.
- If batteries are already leaked, remove them from the battery compartment with a clean cloth. Dispose the batteries in accordance with the provisions. Avoid to contact the leaked battery acid.
- The batteries must be removed from the appliance before it is scrapped. Do not remove the build-in battery yourself! Bring the appliance to a qualified professional.
- The batteries is to be disposed of safely.
- CAUTION! There is a danger of explosion if the batteries are inserted incorrectly. Use

only the same battery types.

Do not use old and new batteries together and of different type from different manufacturer.

- Always insert batteries in accordance (+) and (-) polarity as illustrated in the battery compartment.
- Batteries are life-threatening if swallowed. Store all batteries out of the reach of the children. Seek medical help immediately if batteries are swallowed.
- Do not allow children to change batteries.
- Remove the batteries when you are not going to be using the product for a long period of time.

Warranty

Any defect affecting the functionality of the appliance which becomes apparent within one year after purchase will be repaired by free repair or re-placement provided the appliance has been used and maintained in accordance with the instructions and has not been abused or misused in any way.
