





- 1. Clicking here will bring up a dropdown list where you can connect to Wi-Fi and perform software upgrades.
- 2. Entry to local Al battles, click to navigate to Figure 2.




- 3. Online battles, support chess.com, lichens, and checked. Click to navigate to Figure 6.
- 4. Third-party applications, including Chess Bojo, chess for Android, chess PGN Master, and white pawn. Click to navigate to Figure 8.
- 5. Learn Chess mode, where you can learn basic chess knowledge, chess openings, and cand Hess puzzles. Supports chess.com, lichens, and chesskid.
- 6. Download chess engines compatible with LCO and train personalized chess neural network engines. Click to navigate to Figure 7.
- 7. Career mode, where players can be matched with Al opponents of corresponding skill levels based on adaptive difficulty.
- 8. Store users' saved chess records.
- 9. Supports face-to-face battles between two players and offers multiple game modes.
- 10. Button to turn on Wi-Fi. Please ensure that it is already enabled if you require Wi-Fi.
- 11. The system settings button, allows you to connect to Wi-Fi and check for software updates. Click to navigate to Figure 3.




- 12. Entry points to connect to Wi-Fi.
- 13. Check and update software.
- 14. This MAIA human-like chess Al engine offers difficulty levels ranging from 1100 to 1900 ELO.
- 15. This is the LCO engine that requires loading a network for battles.
- 16. The network can be downloaded or trained in Chess Engine (6).




- 17. VERSUS BOT + ONLINE MATCH
- 18. This button can enable reminders during the game. When activated, pick up the chess piece you want to move, and the board will illuminate.



- 19. The colour transitions from deep green to deep red indicate the quality of the movie.
- 20. This button opens the game analysis, and when activated, it displays the user's current position advantage or disadvantage.
- 21. Values above 0 indicate an advantage, while values below 0 indicate a disadvantage.



- 22. It also plots a curve depicting the user's advantages or disadvantages throughout the entire game.
- 23. This is an open LCO neural network file download platform that provides various popular LCO chess networks for online battles.
- 24. This is the entry point for customizing chess neural networks.
- 25. Choose the chess position you want to train.



- 26. Select which side you want to train.
- 27. Once you have selected a chessboard from 20 to 200 positions, you can submit the data for training.
- 28. This is an ongoing training task. You can download it once the background training is completed.
- 29. This is a completed task. After downloading, you can load it in LCO for gameplay. Clicking View Report will redirect you to Figure 1I to view the training results.
