



How to use

1.




After opening the charging case, the headset will automatically turn on, and the left and right headsets will automatically complete pairing. Turn on BT on your phone and search for the BT device •Hoco EQ20". You need to manually connect the device for the first time, and a prompt tone will sound after successful connection.

- 2. Place the headset in the charging case and close the charging case lid to shut down.
- 3. connect two mobile phones at the same bme: after the headset 'HDCO E020" is

connected to the first mobile phone, turn off the BT of the first mobile phone, turn on the BT of the second mobile phone to connect to this headset, after the connection is successful turn on the BT of the first mobile phone, click "HOCO E020" to connect, this way you can connect two mobile phones at the same time.
